Programmatic Summary & Goals:

This grant will enable the Milwaukee Police Department to respond in a variety of ways to challenges brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic. Funding will reimburse overtime used for relevant duties or in response to staffing shortages attributed to exposure or quarantine regulations. Funds will be used to purchase additional prisoner conveyance vehicles, portable messaging signs, the research and implementation of an online incident reporting system, as well as computers, software, and audio/visual teleconferencing upgrades to support the recent shift to "remote work" and virtual meetings. Several sinks will be installed and a district prisoner processing facility will be renovated to increase cleanliness and lessen the overall exposure of employees and prisoners to COVID-19. Additional funds will be used to upgrade many restroom facilities, drinking fountains, and doors in numerous work locations to be "hands free."
