



## Equity Impact Statement

1. Describe the proposed ordinance or resolution.

The 2021 High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) grant is an ongoing grant that will provide funding for the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) to reduce crime and enhance the quality of life in the City of Milwaukee by reducing the volume of controlled substances in the Milwaukee area. The grant will provide funding for overtime, equipment, and partially fund the salaries and fringe benefits of MPD personnel assigned to five task forces within the HIDTA initiative: Interdiction, Investigative Support, Gang Drug, Fugitive, and Opioid task forces. Multi-jurisdictional task forces enhance inter-agency cooperation, intelligence sharing, and lead to successful prosecutions for drug crimes.

No equity impacts are anticipated.
