There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

## Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

## ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

This report is written by Police Officer Michael WARD, assigned to District 6, Early Power Community Liaison Office. On this day I was assigned to Squad 6264 with Police Officer Fabian GARCIA.

On Wednesday, March 10, 2021, we conducted a CPTED Survey of 700 E. Layton Ave.. We were met by future Owner and Agent, Daniel MARTINEZ.

The location is currently operating as Brass Monkey restaurant. MARTINEZ stated he will be keeping the same floor and security plan of the existing business.

MARTINEZ stated he will be painting the exterior of the building when he takes ownership and at that time he will enlarge the numbers of the address so they are more visible on the exterior of the building. MARTINEZ stated he will also be adding the address to the business' standalone sign.

MARTINEZ stated he is willing to be a standing complainant regarding any loiters on his business, MARTINEZ stated he would try and handle in house before calling the police for assistance.

I observed exterior lighting on the business, but did not observe lighting during hours of darkness.

MARTINEZ was given contact information for District 6, Non-Emergency, and other city services. MARTINEZ was advised to place the contact info at the bar next to the phone.

MARTINEZ stated the location has a second floor that is only accessed through the kitchen.

MARTINEZ stated the door on the main floor and second floor hall is locked and secured.

MARTINEZ stated no one occupies the second floor and there are no business plans to utilize it.

This concludes my report.



- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.


