There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. Hey Tyrone,

I am hoping you can help me with something. We have an establishment who has had some compliance issues in the past as it relates to physical distancing, masks, capacity.

8/7/2020 -We did weekend surveillance of Truth Lounge on Friday, August 7th as part of a series of checks (complaint based).

The inspector stated, "On Friday night during our inspections, Truth Lounge at 1111 N Old world Third St was seen operating at almost 100%, no social distancing, masks not being enforced, and 50% occupancy not posted. We did a

verbal warning (educational consult) because they hadn't been talked to yet. We will definitely have to go back to do another check during weekend/late night inspections.

8/15/2020 – weekend inspection-few customers, but in compliance.

Our process at the time for covid related complaints was as follows:

The Process:

Step 1 = If we receive a complaint of non-compliance, we will have a phone conversation advising what the requirements are, talk through any challenges the operator faces gaining compliance, and offer solutions. We let them know we will be spot-checking in the near future for compliance and if not in compliance, a warning letter and subsequent citation could be issued.

Step 2 = We will do an onsite inspection after step 1 to confirm compliance. If the operator is not in compliance, the inspector will notify the operator a warning letter will be mailed stating details about what was observed and on what date.

Step 3 = If another complaint for the same establishment is received we will follow up and check for compliance. If compliance is not witnessed, a citation shall be issued.

This operator has not been issued a Warning Letter yet by MHD as they have been compliant upon our spot check (Step 2) on 8/15. Alderman Bauman's office reached out with the attached information from MPD from an earlier date than our inspections above, when MPD officers were onsite and they were over capacity and also had a large fight/property damage occur on 7/18. They are wondering if further enforcement can be taken due to this earlier compliance issue with capacity?

Can you weigh in? Please let me know if I can clarify anything for you. ~Carly

Thank you, Carly. FWIW, while MPD was in Truth Lounge on July, 18, 2020 for an unrelated issue, they counted 90 people inside, with about 20 loitering outside.

Their normal non-Covd-19 occupancy is 90; they were at 100% capacity. The previous year (2019), they received a citation for overcapacity (193 people). Letting you know all this as they have had a history of not adhering to occupancy limits.

8/15/2020 – weekend inspection- few customers, but in compliance.

That is the last check we have done for this location and have not received further complaints since.

I will also add I have spoken to Tino previously as he reached out about capabilities for hookah in his Truth Lounge establishment and he was being proactive to find out what is allowed and not allowed based on current orders.

Eric ELIM approached and identified himself as the owner. He did acknowledge that patrons were inside after closing, stating they were just taking pictures. He was advised a PA33 would be filed and an explanation of hours of operation.

- 4. On 08/17/2019 at 12:16am officers were flagged down by security at Truth Lounge, 1111 N. Old World Third St for a subject refusing to leave the bar. The subject was observed going behind the bar making her own drinks and refused several requests to leave. The subject refused the officers request to leave and was arrested for Disorderly Conduct.
- 5. On 09/01/2019 at 1:00am officers observed several people running out of Truth Lounge, yelling about a disturbance. The officer spoke with the applicant who stated two groups of patrons were arguing and started pushing each other. He had security separate the subjects and kick them out. He then closed the bar for the night to avoid any more problems. Other officers were flagged down for a subject bleeding in a parking lot at 320 W. Highland Av. the subject did not want a police report but stated he left Truth Lounge and was jumped by a group that also left Truth Lounge. Officers were also dispatched to 1110 N. 6. On 07/17/20 at approximately 12:35am officers were on foot patrol near the location of 1111 N. Old World Third St., Truth Lounge. The establishment was near capacity of 90 patrons, with approximately 20 patrons loitering outside the location. Officers observed 4 patrons of Truth Lounge engaged in a physical fight directly outside on the side walk. Outside seating consisting of umbrellas, tables, and chairs of Truth Lounge were used in the fight. Several chairs were thrown and used as weapons. A large group consisting of patrons gathered outside of Truth Longue. The group circled the fight, with some of the on-lookers now participating in the melee, by striking people. During the melee a parked vehicle sustained damage, from the chairs being thrown. Officers were able to disburse the fight and during assessing the damage, a second fight occurred. The fight occurred in the same spot, in front of Truth Longue. The fight and scene required 6 uniformed officers, 2 horseback officers, and 1 police sergeant to re-establish order. During the police investigation Truth Longue personal were uncooperative with investigating officers. The agent of the location was on scene and was sincerely concerned over the 2 fights that occurred, and the interaction of his staff towards investigation officers.


