on top of the Hood. The "k" will be 3'-3" Tall with "inn" 2'-4" Tall. The overall Width of "kinn" is 104". The letters are 4" deep. The top "kinn" portion of the sign will be externally

illuminated by a LED light bar installed on the front, top edge of the "hood". The

"GUESTHOUSE MKE" copy will be Acrylic Flat Cut Out, stud mounted letters that are flush

mounted on the front of the "hood", and will 8" Tall by 135" Wide. The "GUESTHOUSE MKE" portion of the sign will not have external illumination. All exposed surfaces will be

painted Gold.
