1) 295-403.3.b All areas used for the parking of motor vehicles or trailers shall have paved or approved surfaces, as required in s. 252-74.

252-74.1 PAVEMENT. All parking lots, parking spaces, parking areas and all access roads, drives or lanes leading thereto shall have a surface of concrete, asphalt macadam or tar macadam. Crushed stone, sand, gravel or cinders shall not be used for the surfacing materials.

YOU ARE THEREFORE ORDERED TO DISCONTINUE PARKING ON UNPAVED OR IMPROPERLY PAVED AREAS.

2) 295-505-4.b-5 Discontinue parking more than one commercial vehicle on the property.

When a property is reinspected and violations remain uncorrected, the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances provides for these reinspection fees:

First reinspection \$177.80 Second reinspection \$355.60 All subsequent reinspections \$355.60

There is no charge for the reinspection that shows compliance with all violations.

All reinspections which show noncompliance with the order will be charged at the above rate. These fees will be assessed against the property as a special charge and will appear on the tax bill for this property. On 04/19/2021, we imposed a \$355.60 reinspection fee, which includes a 1.6% training and technology surcharge. Any outstanding fees will automatically be assessed to your 2021 tax bill.

As you can see, the cost of noncompliance with the code can add up quickly. The Department would prefer to see you put the money into correcting the violations and not into paying reinspection fees. Please contact me as soon as the violations have been corrected. If I do not hear from you, we will continue to reinspect until the property has been brought into compliance with the code. Please do not put us in that situation.

If you wish to appeal this charge you must file that appeal within 30 days of the date of this letter. It must be filed with the: Administrative Review and Appeals Board, Office of the City Clerk, Room 205 City Hall, 200 E Wells Street, Milwaukee Wisconsin 53202, 414-286-2221. Please contact them to obtain the proper application form. There is a \$25 fee required when filing this appeal.

Please be advised that if you have filed for bankruptcy, this letter is for informational purposes and is not intended as to be construed as an attempt to collect a debt during the pendency of your bankruptcy as other conditions may apply.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A CLAIM AGAINST THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE

To file a claim against the City a claimant must comply with Section 893.80(1), Wis. Stats., a copy of which is printed at the bottom of this instruction sheet. Generally the statute requires the claimant to submit to the City Clerk:

- A document stating the circumstances of the claim which must be signed by the claimant, or his/her agent or attorney. This document should be filed within 120 days of the event.
- A document stating the address of the claimant and a statement of the relief sought. If money damages are sought, a specific sum must be stated.

(The above information may be combined in a single document.)

The following information should also be submitted to allow the City to promptly act on your claim:

- Proof of the amount of the claim by means of either itemized receipts or two itemized estimates.
- 2. A phone number where the claimant can be reached during business hours as well as the claimant's e-mail address, if any.
- 3. As detailed a description of the incident as possible, including the date, time and place.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Before you can file a lawsuit against the City of Milwaukee for reimbursement, State law requires that you first follow the claim procedures established by the City Clerk.

Filing a claim against the City does not automatically guarantee reimbursement from the City. However, the City examines each claim on an individual basis in determining if reimbursement is legally required.

In order to obtain reimbursement for a claim against the City, you must prove that the City or its employees acted unlawfully or negligently.

Only the City Attorney or the Common Council and the Mayor can authorize payment of a claim against the City. Any other representations made by City employees are not legally binding on the City.

893.80 Claims against governmental bodies or officers, agents or employees; notice of injury; limitation of damages and suits. (1) Except as provided in subs. (1g), (1m), (1p) and (8), no action may be brought or maintained against any volunteer fire company organized under ch. 213, political corporation, governmental subdivision or agency thereof nor against any officer, official, agent or employee of the corporation, subdivision or agency for acts done in their official capacity or in the course of their agency or employment upon a claim or cause of action unless:

- (a) Within 120 days after the happening of the event giving rise to the claim, written notice of the circumstances of the claim signed by the party, agent or attorney is served on the volunteer fire company, political corporation, governmental subdivision or agency and on the officer, official, agent or employee under s. 801.11. Failure to give the requisite notice shall not bar action on the claim if the fire company, corporation, subdivision or agency had actual notice of the claim and the claimant shows to the satisfaction of the court that the delay or failure to give the requisite notice has not been prejudicial to the defendant fire company, corporation, subdivision or agency or to the defendant officer, official, agent or employee; and
- (b) A claim containing the address of the claimant and an itemized statement of the relief sought is presented to the appropriate clerk or person who performs the duties of a clerk or secretary for the defendant fire company, corporation, subdivision or agency and the claim is disallowed.

Typed version of my appeal.

1st part: The reason for sending in my appeal late was I was sent the wrong form from the phone number on Ord-21-00914, it was a form for filing a claim against the city of Milwaukee. By the time I got the proper info 30 days had passed. The reason for my appeal is from the original Ord-20-05683 I contacted inspector Kenitz regarding my tractor that I use a to maintain my property and a wood splitter that I also had on the grass. I specifically asked him if those could be kept on the grass, I never received an answer back. After receiving Ord-21-00914 I looked up the definition of a vehicle online and found that on Nov. 18,2010 (Wislawjournal.com News) WI court of appeals held that a tractor was not a motor vehicle under policy defining the term as a vehicle designated for use on public roads. Therefore if I would've had guidance I requested from Inspector Kenitz that he did not want me to park those on the grass, I would've made sure to have them on my driveway or in the garage. I ask that the charges be rescinded and going forward I will not park it on the grass now that I know.
