#### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

This report was written by Police Officer Fabian GARCIA assigned to District Six-Early Power, Squad 6264, Community Liaison Officer/Community Prosecution Unit.

On Tuesday, May 4, 2021, at 5pm, Officer Ward and I meet with Urban Tea Company owner Nicholas T. Nowaczyk. Nicholas stated that he plans on opening Monday-Sunday 7am-7pm. Nicholas stated the retail section will be located on the north end of the building and the bar is located on the south end of the business where you can purchase tea to drink in store. Nicholas is also planning on selling beer and wine. Nicholas will also have seating tables for customs centrally located in the property.

There are no exterior cameras at this time and does have four working cameras located in the interior. One camera faces the front entrance and exit door, one camera faces the bar/cashier area, one camera facing the main lobby, and one camera facing the rear door, which employees can only access. Nicholas will be placing motion sensors on doors and will place additional lighting to the rear of the building. Nicholas stated he has not attended a Robbery Prevention Training but was provided the Community Outreach and Education phone number.




### City Concentration Map 3060 S 13th St


