D. EXCEPTIONS

1. Vehicles bearing current registration plates for disabled drivers issued under Wis.stat. § 341.14(1), (1a), (1m), or (1q), or a motor vehicle under which a current special identification card issued under Wis. Stat. § 343.51, is displayed, except motor buses and motor trucks, shall be exempt from purchasing overnight parking permits, but shall be required to park in accordance with all other provisions of the all-night parking ordinance. Those vehicles displaying a 'disabled driver' hang-tag must obtain a special disabled night permit, but it is free of charge and is available only at police district stations at any of the City of Milwaukee Violation Bureaus and online at www.milwaukee.gov/parking.

F. TRIMESTER PARKING PERMIT SALE PROCEDURES

Information regarding the sale and purchase of parking permits can be located online at www.milwaukee.gov/parking.

- 1. The sale of permits for each trimester shall begin on the 20th of the month prior to the beginning of the trimester (April 20th, August 20th, and December 20th of each year).
- 2. Citizens may purchase a parking permit online at www.milwaukee.gov/parking; at the self-service kiosks at districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, regardless of where they reside; at the three city of Milwaukee Violation Bureaus; or at the city of Milwaukee tow lot.
