- 6. On 11/04/20 at 10:06pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to St Mary's Hospital 2301 N. Lake Dr. for a sick and injured complaint. Officers identified the victim of a substantial battery and located a scene at 2237 N. Holton St. Officers spoke with the clerk at the gas station who allowed officers to review video of the incident. Officers discovered that the victim was panhandling outside the location and got into a physical altercation with the suspect who was also panhandling. The suspect during the altercation struck the victim with a glass bottle causing injury. The gas station clerk stated to officers that the subjects usually panhandle near the business. When the subjects are told to leave they become verbally and physically combative.
- 7. On 03/30/21 at approximately 9:00pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 2237 N. Holton St. during the course of the premise check other officers were responding to a robbery investigation. The business was cooperative with the officers and provided video, of the incident. The video revealed that the incident took place outside on the lot of the gas station. From the video officers were able to determine the time frame of the incindet, the suspect and vehicle description.

This report is written by P.O. Adam MARITATO, District Five, Late Power Shift. On Tuesday, January 21, 2020 at 10:19 p.m. Squad 5468 (myself and P.O. Robert PARKS) conducted a License Premise Check at 2237 N. Holton St. (Milwaukee Metro LLC) in the city of Milwaukee.

On scene I spoke with the employee at the location, identified as Armando A SULEYMAN (b/m 01-01-78). SULEYMAN stated his shift hours for the day were 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. SULEYMAN stated he is employed as a cashier. I inquired as to where the licenses for the business were located. SULEYMAN was unsure but stated he would contact the owner.

On scene he contacted the agent for the business, identified as Prital S GREWAL (w/m 04-26-81). I spoke with GREWAL and he informed me where the licenses were located. While on the phone I informed him that a report would be written. I informed GREWAL at 10:27 p.m.

I observed the below listed licenses:

- Filling Station (0001196) which is valid from 06-20-19 to 06-19-20
- Extended Hours (0199073) which is valid from 06-20-19 to 06-19-20
- Food Dealer (0008776) which is valid from 06-20-19 to 06-19-20

P.O. PARKS did not observe any expired dairy but did observe a half empty open gallon of milk. We informed SULEYMAN of this. SULEYMAN stated that the person who works during the day drinks out of it. We informed him to move it away from other products for sale.

This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5, Late Power Shift, Sq. 5468 with PO Russell MACRAE.

On 11/12/20 at 10:06 p.m., we responded to a sick and injured complaint at Columbia St. Mary's Hospital, located at 2301 N. Lake Dr. ER room 16.

While driving to the hospital, the CAD read that we were to meet Sq. 4431 who, while traveling to Columbia St. Mary's with their own person in need of medical help, was flagged down by citizens at 416 E. North Ave., for a male that was sitting on the curb in front of this address, bleeding from the head. They contacted medical and the subject was then transported to Columbia St. Mary's for medical treatment.

Upon arrival at the hospital, I spoke with Sq. 4431 (PO STAMPS and PO RUMMEL) who stated they were taking a person to the hospital, when they were flagged down for the person sitting on the curb. They attempted to gather information regarding how this person was sitting on the curb and bleeding from the head, but the person told them that he was not a snitch and did not want to speak to them about what happened. They were not able to verbally gather the persons name. The person bleeding was also holding paper towel against his head, which was given to the male by the gas station attendant, located at 2237 N. Holton St.

PO MACRAE entered ER room 16 and found that the person who was transported by Sq. 4431 was sleeping in his bed. PO MACRAE then began to access the males possible injury. PO MACRAE observed about a 3 inch laceration to the top of the males head, which the skin from the laceration was raised and you could see the raised skin from the males right side. PO MACRAE attempted to wake the male, who did not wake up in order to make a statement. I then began to speak to the nurse for room 16, who stated they did not have any information on the occupant of room 16, no name or verbal claim of injury.

While speaking to the nurse, PO MACRAE was able to locate a Wisconsin photo identification card of the male. The name on the identification card was Aaron C. WEST (b/m 03-24-71). PO MACRAE also located two City of Milwaukee Municipal citations that were issued to WEST from the prior week for disorderly conduct and vandalism. We gave this information to the nurse so that their medical records could be updated for the care of WEST. We were also informed that WEST, upon arrival at the hospital was being loud and not cooperating with staff, so WEST was given Haldol, so that he would calm down and that he could be treated. We were also informed that WEST would not be waking up for an hour or two and that we would not be able to have our questions answered by WEST at this time. We left our contact card with WEST if he wished to contact us at a later time regarding this incident. WEST was treated by Dr. Laurie BENSON and admitted at 9:20 p.m.

We then went back to the intersection of E. North Ave. and N. Holton St., in order to locate a possible scene for this incident. Upon arrival I exited our fully marked Police Explorer and began walking around Holton Food & Liquor, located at 2305 N. Holton St. I immediately observed blood on the sidewalk on the southside of the building. The blood trail was from the southeast corner and continued west on the sidewalk, along a wheel chair ram, which runs the southside of the building. I followed the blood trail to the end of the ramp and then up the ramp, going east to the entrance door of the business. I was able to look inside of the glass door with my flashlight, but did not see any signs of a struggle or blood on the

floor of the store.

I then walked back down the ramp and once at the end of the ramp, I continued west, along the southside of the building, again following more blood, which stopped at the west side of the business, in front of small field in front a chain linked fence. There was a large amount of blood in front of the fence, with white paper towel lying on the sidewalk. PO MACRAE then informed me that he was watching the store video from the gas station at 2237 N. Holton St.

I began to cross E. North Ave., in order to review the video and observed a blood trail going across E. North Ave., which led into the gas station parking lot. As I continued to walk the parking lot of the gas station, I observed a trail of blood, which led to the east side of the store portion of the gas station, in front of the windows where the clerks are working. It should be noted as I was following the blood trails, I was verbally narrating where the blood was, as I was trying to gather this evidence on my body worn camera.

I entered the gas station and found PO MACRAE watching the video. PO MACRAE informed me that WEST was standing outside of the clerks windows, panhandling, along with two other individuals, Michael CUNNINGHAM and and Cortez ROYSTER. WEST is standing outside, when ROYSTER punches WEST one time in the head, causing WEST to fall to the ground, when CUNNINGHAM walks up to WEST and throws a bottle of what would later be Hennesy at the head of WEST. Once CUNNINGHAM throws the bottle, CUNNUNGHAM then stomps on the left shoulder area of WEST with his foot. CUNNINGHAM stops, when a patron approaches him. CUNNINGHAM and ROYSTER then walk north and west in the parking lot, leaving the view of the camera. WEST stays on the ground for a moment, and gets up. He then begins to walk around the parking lot, ultimately being stopped by Sq. 4431. This incident with WEST occurred at 2237 N. Holton St.

I then watched the video, and started to watch around the time of 7:35 p.m., and you see CUNNINGHAM, ROYSTER and WEST approaching customers speaking with them, or doing things such as putting air in peoples tires. While watching the video at 7:50 p.m., WEST and CUNNINGHAM begin to argue in the parking lot. WEST is swaying and appears to be heavily intoxicated. WEST and CUNNINGHAM continue to argue, when CUNNINGHAM appears to square his body at WEST, raising his fists towards his head, as if he was going to box (fight) WEST. WEST then begins to walk back towards the glass in front of the clerk and CUNNINGHAM appears to walk back towards the entrance to the store of the gas station, where he stands against the wall.

At 7:53 p.m., ROYSTER, who was standing at the southeast corner of the store, during the argument, puts on a yellow jacket and walks north towards WEST. It appears that WEST and ROYSTER are talking or starting to argue with each other, when ROYSTER punches WEST in the head once, causing WEST to fall the the ground. CUNNINGHAM then walks up on WEST, while on the ground, throwing a bottle at the head of WEST and then begins to stomp WEST several times in the left shoulder area. They both begin to leave when a customer approaches them about this incident. While leaving ROYSTER takes a white box filled with liquor, belonging to WEST and CUNNINGHAM and ROYSTER walk west out of the camera view. WEST does stand up and eventually is stopped the District 4 squad and taken to the hospital.

The staff at the gas station was spoken to and they informed us that prior to this incident, WEST had a

Hennesy bottle, which he gave to CUNNINGHAM to consume. The staff at the gas station informed us that these people constantly cause a problem at the gas station and that when they are told to leave, especially CUNNINGHAM, they become combative verbally and physically. The owner of the gas station, at this time has not taken out restraining orders on any of theses individuals, according to the employees of the gas station. PO MACRAE and I have in the past informed them to contact the owner of the gas station, Pritpal GREWAL, in order to put in place a restraining order. GREWAL has done this for people panhandling at his other gas stations.

We were then flagged down by a business owner near the gas station, who walked us around the area, showing us where the three like to hang around, vacant houses to the south of the gas station, as well as the alley way to the west of the gas station, but we did not locate anyone.

This license premise report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5 Late Power Shift, Squad 5468 with PO Russell MACRAE.

On 03-30-21 we conducted a licensed premise check of Citgo on Holton, located at 2237 N. Holton St., which is a licensed gas station in the city of Milwaukee.

Upon arriving at the location, there were other officers at the gas station regarding an armed robbery that occurred on the gas station parking lot, IR 21-089-0203. (see below)

We conducted the inspection of the Filling Station License (Fill 1391), which is valid and set to expire 06-19-21.

While at the gas station, the officers who were investigating the armed robbery needed assistance in reviewing the camera system, which captured the armed robbery. PO MACRAE and I asked the clerk Shamsher SINGH if we could retrieve the video regarding the armed robbery. He allowed us to record the video.

PO MACRAE contacted the listed agent, Pritpal GREWAL via the telephone and spoke to him regarding the incidents at the gas station. PO MACRAE left information for GREWAL regarding GREWAL being a standing complainant for future incidents at the gas station. GREWAL stated he would take care of the paperwork and return it to District 5.

This report is written by PO Robert LLOYD, assigned to District 5 - Late Power Shift.

On Tuesday, March 30th 2021 at approximately 8:40 PM, Squad 5469 (PO Robert LLOYD/PO Robert PARKS), in full duty uniform, equipped with Axon body worn cameras, and operating a marked MPD squad car, was flagged down for an Armed Robbery Call for Service at 2237 N Holton St (Citgo Gas Station) in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI 53212.

#### Victim Interview:

I spoke to Rafeal D SANDERS (B/M) 09/22/1985, the listed victim. SANDERS stated that he was at the above listed location pumping gas for people in exchange for tips, which he stated is a normal thing for him to engage in at this location. SANDERS stated that he observed one of his regular "customers" pull up to pump #2. SANDERS described this person as a B/M, young, and who he calls "fam". SANDERS stated that "fam" is a known drug dealer and that he has frequently bought narcotics (crack/marijuana)

from "fam". SANDERS stated that he spoke to "fam" and told him he would like to purchase \$20 of marijuana. SANDERS stated he got \$20 of US currency out of his pocket and produced it, at which point "fam" forcefully took the currency from SANDERS' hands and walked away without returning. SANDERS stated that "fam" returned to his vehicle and then moved the vehicle to the North side of the building.

SANDERS stated that he approached "fam" again to ask him for his money back, at which point "fam" exited the driver seat, armed himself with a black shotgun/rifle and pointed it at him. SANDERS stated "fam" got back into the vehicle and fled West on East North Ave.

SANDERS stated he did not consent to the suspects action and that he wishes to prosecute.

## Suspect Description:

B/M 6'2, thin build, wearing a orange and blue hooded sweatshirt with an orange hood, blue jeans, black shoes, and armed with a black shotgun/rifle.

Vehicle: Silver Infiniti Sedan G37 4 door, no tints, dealer plate in the rear, temp tag on the driver side rear window.

## Witnesses/Surveillance Footage:

Footage at the location corroborated SANDERS statement. Footage showed SANDERS with what appeared to be US currency in his hands standing in-front of the subjects vehicle which was parked at pump #2.
