With Covid-19 I wish I could have done more of it. Talking about the Brewers and the rest is fun but doing it in front of the store for some reason just attracts trouble. It has to stop but it is the most

natural thing for a fellow like me to do.

> The staff at the store are over worked. I have seen the same two men tending this store for what has to be 12 hours a day each day seven days a week over a little more than one year. They are good men but you can see on their faces how it drains them. They get impatient. Maybe ask for (Subpoena?) the security video of the store and you will see these two good men in there, all the time. This is inhumane. These men need to be treated better. The men may be visiting from outside our country and do not know about our labor custom of only working 8 hours a day. These men are not going to be at the top of their game mentally or physically. Rules may be over looked though I have never witnessed it.

> There is a playground going in next door. I prefer the playground with out the store. A mother in her right mind would not take her children to a playground in front of a store selling beer. This goes directly to what kind of neighborhood so you want? I prefer one without beer being sold at the boundary of a playground. People buying beer and walking over to the playground and drinking all their beer getting louder and louder as the night goes on. Like used to happen up at the old Merrill Park Playground near 34th and St. Paul Ave.

> As a member of Merrill Park Neighborhood Association and a 20 year resident who sometimes hears shots fired from that general direction I do not want to see Milwaukee Foods receive a "Beer" license.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 07/31/2019 at 5:20am officers were dispatched to an Entry complaint at Milwaukee Food Grocery Store, 2903 W. Clybourn Av. The officer spoke with the manager, who stated he got a call from his alarm company at about 4:51am that the alarm was going off. When he arrived he found the rear door open and called the police. The officer cleared the building and the manager found that cigarettes were taken. The applicant did arrive and was cooperative.
- 2. On 11/21/2019 at 8:07pm officers were dispatched to a Theft complaint at Milwaukee Food Mart, 2903 W. Clybourn Av. The officer interviewed the clerk, who stated a known subject came in the business and took merchandise without paying for it. The officer gave the clerk information on how to obtain a restraining order.

3. On 01/15/21 at 5:13pm, officers were dispatched to a Theft at Milwaukee Foods Grocery and Deli (2903 W. Clybourn) for a Theft from Person. Officers interviewed the victim who stated he was in line at the checkout, with his firearm sticking out of his pocket, when an unknown juvenile removed it and ran out of the store. The victim gave chase but stopped when the suspect turned and pointed it. The entire incident was captured on video surveillance and the employees were cooperative turning it over to police.

4. On 04/15/21 officers conducted a License Premise check at 2903 W. Clybourn Ave. (Milwaukee Foods Grocery and Deli). Complaints of drug dealing were addressed with the employee. The employee was cooperative with police and stated he works very close with bicycle squads and reports incidents to them. The employee further stated he addresses people who loiter outside of the store and has multiple no loitering signs posted. No violations were observed during the contact.

This report is written by Police Officer Demetrios HUDSON assigned to District 3 Modified Early shit, Community Prosecution Unit.

On April 25th, 2021 at approximately 12:57 PM, my partner Police Officer Taylor Carloni (Sq: 3271) and I (Sq: 3272) conducted a Business Check at the location of 2903 W. Clybourn Street (The Milwaukee Food Market), in the city and county of Milwaukee, Wisconsin for recent neighborhood complaints of "Drug Dealing," and "Loitering."

We spoke with the owner, identified as Pankaj N. Patel (W/M 12/16/1972) who stated the corner store has been opened for approximately 15 years. I informed PATEL that people in the neighborhood are calling on the store stating that there is drug dealing. PATEL stated he works closely with the bicycle squads and reports anything to them, if need be. PATEL stated that he will tell people who loiter outside his store to leave the location if they are there for too long. Additionally, PATEL informed us that the people will tell him to mind his business and because it isn't safe, he will leave it at that. PATEL stated, typically, guys will be across the street loitering but not in front of the store.

I did check and the store has multiple "No Loitering Signs."

PATEL was given a contact card.

On Friday, 01-15-21, Squad 3255 (P.O. WEILAND and I) was dispatched at 5:13 PM to a Theft From Person at 2903 W Clybourn St (Milwaukee Foods Grocery and Deli). Upon arrival I spoke to the victim outside identified as Nathaniel C. HENNING (B/M 03-26-90) who stated an unknown younger black male

approached him from behind while he was checking out at the front of the store and stole his firearm from his right pocket that was visibly sticking out of his pocket. HENNING stated the suspect then ran out of the store running southbound on N 29th St from W Clybourn St and he ran after the suspect. HENNING stated the suspect while running turned around and pointed the stolen firearm at HENNING at which point HENNING stopped chasing the suspect and the suspect kept running southbound. HENNING stated the suspect was initially inside the store with two other B/M juveniles who were wearing all black. HENNING stated the suspect who took his firearm was a B/M, approximately 16-18 years old, dark complexion, low haircut, wearing a black hoodie, black sweats, and white Nike Air Max with black trim. HENNING stated the firearm that was stolen was a Springfield XDM 9, Serial #GM758976. See P.O. WEILAND's supplemental report regarding an interview with the cashier who witnessed the incident.

The incident was all captured on surveillance cameras from the store and I was able to obtain the following suspect description from the video:

Suspect Description:

B/M approximately 16-18 years old, medium build, low haircut, wearing blue sweatshirt with red and yellow writing/logo, black sweatpants with white writing, white Nike Airmax with black trim.

The video surveillance detailed that the suspect approaches HENNING from behind while he was checking out his items. The suspect runs up and grabs the firearm from HENNING's right pocket and then proceeds to run out of the front door of the store and then southbound on N 29th St. The video shows HENNING give chase behind the suspect then we observed the suspect turn around and point the stolen firearm at HENNING. HENNING then stops running and the suspects proceeds to keep running southbound on N 29th St.

Squad 3252 (P.O. KUNYA and P.O. MADRIGAL) responded to the scene and P.O. KUNYA was able to burn a DVD copy of the video surveillance. See P.O. KUNYA's CST supplemental report regarding. P.O. WEILAND placed a copy of the video on MPD Inventory INV#21001978

I notified Lt GRANT at District #3 who instructed the investigation was ours to conduct.



The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 6/22/2021 at 10:45 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
