Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The officer observed a pack of cigarettes next to the register but the clerk denied they were for selling single cigarettes. The officer advised that a secret shopper may come in a check to see if the business is selling singles cigarettes in the future.

The clerk stated the business stopped selling alcohol at 9:00pm but remained open for food sales until 10:00pm. ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Happy Food Mart at 103 E. Keefe Av is an established business that is changing ownership. I observed the business to be clean and in good order. The camera system is recording 16 cameras, and does not have a hard drive large enough to store more than 2 weeks of video. The exterior windows have large security gates, and the interior is covered by shelves. Large signs are also posted on the windows which make it impossible to see inside the business. Owner did state that he would be removing the signs. I suggested more exterior cameras to cover the large building. The owner sells glass pipes that are commonly used to smoke drugs, both Marijuana and Crack. The store sells CBD and Hookah pipes and accessories. The business only sells beer. The business does not have a safe for drop money. We provided a contact guide and printed off information regarding robbery prevention training. The owner was receptive to suggestions regarding security related matters at the business.




City Concentration Map 103 E Keefe Ave Milwaukee

- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished:
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
