**Proposal** Extensive exterior rehabilitation, including: new asphalt shingle roof; repair/salvage/reuse of existing trim with repair and replacement to match as needed; new K-style aluminum gutters and downspouts; new smooth surfaced siding; new replacement clad wood windows; replacement of basement windows; new paneled doors; salvage/reuse/repair or match historical cornice and columns; chimney tuckpointing as needed.

Extensive interior demolition including: staircase; interior walls; removal of existing electrical, ductwork, mechanical units, HVAC equipment, and plumbing; removal of flooring to wood floor or subfloors throughout house; removal of existing interior doors and frames; stripping existing walls and ceilings to bare studs; and demolition of existing front porch, deck, steps, and railings. Porch and staircase will be replaced; new walls will be erected; kitchen will be relocated, resulting in some interior reconfiguration; new attic scuttle will be installed; and compliant smoke, CO detectors, bathroom exhaust, plumbing, and wall/ceiling insulation will be installed.

**Staff comments**

1. As stated in the general project conditions, the pseudo-Palladian window arch hood on the west elevation should be recreated. Of the subject properties, 4481 N 25<sup>th</sup> Street has the detail somewhat intact and it can be measured so that it can be scaled to the surviving drawings for reproduction.
2. The windows at this home appear more likely to be salvageable than others, but the extensive boarding makes this unclear. Existing storm windows are heavily damaged and appear to be undesirable triple-track aluminum. The state of original windows should be evaluated more closely.
