Dear Commissioner Roberts,

Pursuant to City of Milwaukee Ordinance 80-10, I respectfully request that a special charge of **\$2,362.23** be placed against the premises located at **3018-3020 N. Palmer Street**, for the cost of police services, which took place at **5:50pm on May 31, 2021 for Shooting: 80-10-2-c-1-L**. The cause for this response was for action(s) or behavior(s) that are prohibited by Milwaukee City Ordinance 80-10. In addition, there will be an Administrative fee of \$25.00 per property for costs incurred by the Department of Neighborhood Services. Each instance of nuisance activity occurring at the property may be deemed a separate violation of the ordinance and is subject to billing. Once the owner/licensee has been billed on three (3) or more separate dates within one-year time period for the costs of enforcement concerning nuisance activities, this property may be deemed a chronic nuisance pursuant to Section 80-10(6)(MCO), and each and every subsequent incident of nuisance activity at this property may result in a citation(s) being issued to the owner/licensee for chronic nuisance violations.

The owner of the aforementioned property, **Alberta & Robert Roy, 3018 N. Palmer Street**, will be apprised of this cost referral request by providing a copy of this letter to said owner. The recipient has the right to appeal pursuant to Sec. 80-10-5 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances within thirty (30) days of this letter. This letter further informs the owner of the premises that any appeal of this charge must be filed with the Administrative Review Appeals Board, Office of the City Clerk, (414) 286-3150. A copy of the specific services provided may be obtained by calling the Open Records Department at (414) 935-7502. Checks should be made payable to City of Milwaukee.
