2. On 12/24/2013 the Wisconsin Department of Transportation revoked Bozana Jovanovich's driver's license for 6 months for Operating While Intoxicated. Bozana Jovanovich is listed on the application as 49% shareholder.

- 3. On 05/22/2014 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a fight at 4410 West Forest Home Avenue (Una's Bar). Officers discovered that there had been a fight inside the bar that continued once the involved parties exited the business. Several of the combatants were conveyed to area hospitals, including one victim that sustained lacerations to his neck, chest and hands requiring more than 20 stitches to repair. Milwaukee police incident report #141420035 filed.
- 4. On 03/27/2015 while investigating a trouble with subject complaint at 4410 West Forest Home Avenue (Una Café), officers conducted a licensed premise check. During this check, officers discovered the Class D operator's license possessed by the bartender, Colleen Santner, had expired on 12/31/2014. The bartender, and the business's manager Amy Seguin who was not in the business at the time of the violation, received a warning regarding this violation.

5. On 04/15/2016 at 2:09am Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 4410 West Forest Home Avenue (Una Café). The officer observed four people inside the business (including the bartender), two of which left prior to any interaction with the officer. The bartender, Nicole Kroha, told the officer she knew that all the people had to be out of the bar at 2:00am, and that she did not serve any drinks after 2:00am. The applicant was cited.

- 6. On 09/18/2017 officers were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon complaint at Una Café Bar, 4410 W. Forest Home Av. The investigation revealed there were two regular customers playing pool. Two unknown subjects came in and played the known customers a game of pool for drinks. A fight started after the unknown patrons lost the game. During the fight one of the unknown patrons, Tamane JOHNSON, was armed with a pool cue. The bartender, Alice QUISNO, attempted to break up the fight and was struck in the arm by JOHNSON with the pool cue, causing a piece to be impaled in her forearm. JOHNSON was held by other patrons until the police arrived. The other suspect fled on foot and was not located. There is no video at the location.
- 7. On 03/14/2018 officers were dispatched to an Armed Robbery complaint at Una Café Bar, 4410 W. Forest Home Av. The investigation revealed a subject entered the bar with a gun and a mask covering his face. He obtained money from the bar and property from the patrons. The suspect was last seen fleeing on foot. The bar did not have video surveillance inside or outside.

8.	On 04/13/2019 officers were dispatched to a fight at S. 44 th St and W. Forest Home Av. Upon
	arrival the officers observed and intoxicated subject attempting to get into Una Café, 4410 W.
	Forest Home Av. The subject had a cut and swelling to his lip. The bartender stated there
	were two groups of people arguing in the tavern, possibly about money that was missing from
	the top of the bar. The subjects were asked to leave and began fighting outside. A citizen
	witnessed the fight and informed the bartenders of the fight outside. The subject did not
	reference a fight and stated he just wanted to get his coat. The agent was contacted on
	04/14/2019.

- 9. On 12/29/20 at 10:09pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 4410 W. Forest Home Avenue. No violations were found and the bartender was cooperative.
- 10. On 01/24/21 at 9:12pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4410 W. Forest Home Avenue for a shots fired complaint. Investigation revealed that a fight started inside the establishment and a subject produced a firearm and pointed it at everyone inside the tavern. The fight then resumed outside and someone fired a round from a handgun. All participants in the altercation were gone upon police arrival.
- 11. On 02/25/21 at 7:18pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4410 W. Forest Home Avenue for a trouble with subject complaint. Investigation revealed that a patron would not leave the bathroom because the bartender refused to serve her due to her level of intoxication. The subject left before police arrival.

This report was written by P.O. CARTWRIGHT, assigned to District six, Early. On 01/24/2021, at approximately 9:14 PM Squad 6220 was dispatched for a Shots Fired complaint from the address of 4410 W Forest Home Av, which is Una Cafe.

On arrival I spoke with the bartender of location, Lauren EVANS (w/f 08/23/91) who stated there was a misunderstanding with several patrons over a dart game that led to a small b/m pointing a silver handgun at her and several other patrons in the bar before using the butt of that silver handgun to break a window at location. This was done without consent.

EVANS stated a very small and young looking b/m entered her bar at listed location at approximately 8:00 pm on 01/24/20 with several friends and began to play darts and had a few drinks. EVANS stated the b/m stood out because of his small size and youthful appearance. EVANS stated when she asked for his ID the people with him laughed and stated he is my cousin. EVANS stated there was a tall, slim b/m wearing a hat and approximately 45 yr old and 2 b/fs with the small b/m. b/f #1 was approximately 5"7" 180 lb with red and black braids approximately 30 yr old. b/f #2 5'4" 120 young wearing a blond wig.

EVANS stated there were approximately 12 people in the bar and most were playing darts. EVANS stated there was some kind of misunderstanding where the small b/m thought somebody called his girlfriend a HO. EVANS stated a shoving match quickly ensued between the friends playing darts. EVANS stated the group of people with the small b/m started pushing him toward the front door facing W Forest Home Av in an effort to get him to leave. EVANS stated the group was at the front doors when the small b/m pulled out a silver handgun, held it over his head in his right hand with the handgun tilted sideways and pointed it at her and the the rest of the customers. EVANS stated he then smashed the window next to the front door using the butt of the handgun. EVANS stated after the window was broken all patrons involved in the misunderstanding pushed the b/m out side and started physically fighting and that's when she called 911. EVANS stated they were kicking the shit out of one another and there is blood on the sidewalk just west of the bar. EVANS stated she also heard 1-2 gunshots but was inside the bar and did not see anything else. EVANS stated he does not recognize the people involved but the small b/m may have been in the bar before.

Another bartender, Michaela EVANS (w/f 05/05/96) stated she was outside the bar in her vehicle on W Forest Home Av when the group fighting came outside and starting kicking each other on the sidewalk. Michaela stated they were kicking each other in the head and there was blood. Michaela stated she did not see a gun but heard 1-2 gunshots and-or possibly 1 gunshot and it's echo. Michaela stated she then returned to the bar to check on her co worker. Michaela stated he does not recognize the people involved.

INTERVIEW OF WITNESS: Christopher KARTZ (w/m 08/25/74). KARTZ stated he saw the small b/m with a silver handgun smash the window and continue outside to fight with another person in his group who he

was playing darts with. KARTZ stated he followed the group outside to try and take pictures of them. KARTZ stated he took a picture of a silver car that the people fighting with each other got into and then drove off, unknown make or model and no Lc plate. KARTZ stated the tail b/m stood out because he was wearing stonewash jeans. KARTS stated he does not recognize the people involved.

I observed the photo KARTZ took, from the photo I can only tell that it was a silver car, possibly 4 dr.

I asked KARTZ why he took the risk of following the group when he knew they had a handgun and he simply smirked.

KARTZ appeared very intoxicated.

Officers located what appeared to be a small amount of blood on W Forest Home Av just south of the side of the road and 1 smashed.40 Federal casing INV# 21003034, in the middle of Forest Home Ave west of the bar.

I notified D6 Lt SIMMERT and was advised that it was mine to handle.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 7/13/2021 at 9:05 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel — Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable — or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
