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The resolution authorizes the Department of Public Works to enter into an agreement with KABOOM to donate and install a playground at Butterfly Park, 3717 W. Meinecke. The agreement requests indemnification for KABOOM on behalf of the City of Milwaukee.

2. Identify the anticipated equity impacts, if any, of this proposal.

This proposal would improve recreational access in an area underserved by public parks and play spaces. it will enhance an underutilized park space with new playground features and a community engaged design process.

3. Identify which minority groups, if any, may be negatively or positively impacted by the proposal.

The neighborhood is 96% non-white, and predominantly African-American (74%). 42% of residents live below the poverty level, with a median household income of less than \$24,000.





 Describe any engagement efforts with minority communities potentially impacted by the proposal.

This project is happening in collaboration with Metcalfe Park Community Bridges, a local neighborhood association. They will lead engagement in the playground design process throughout the month of August, 2021. They have already hosted two previous events at which feedback was collected on the preferences for park reconstruction efforts.

5. Describe how any anticipated equity impacts of the proposal will be documented or evaluated.

Upon completion of the project, a survey of neighborhood residents and stakeholders will be conducted in accordance with processes established as part of the MKE Plays initiative and the KABOOM engagement process. This will happen in collaboration with Metcalfe Park Community Bridges.

Describe strategies that will be used, if any, to mitigate any anticipated equity impacts.

As a community-led program, we will work with residents to ensure impact is positive and sustainable. Should concerns arise, they would be addressed in collaboration with neighborhood partners and project committee members.
