This correspondence will serve as an appeal and request for a hearing in relation to the above referenced matter. This request is based on your May 20, 2021 correspondence denying liability for the incident that occurred on January 26, 2021 when the City of Milwaukee's fire truck damaged my Acura resulting in \$3,211.92 in damage.

In relations to this hearing, I will be subpoenaing the following witnesses:

- -the driver of the fire truck for the date of the incident

- -the officer that issued the ticket in this matter
- -other witnesses with direct and indirect knowledge of or about this incident

In addition, I will issuing a subpoena from the records custodian for the police department to include:

- -the human resources records and hard card of the officer who issued the citation in this incident
