There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. This report is written by Police Officer David Novak, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 01/16/2019 officers, along with agents from the WI Department of Revenue, conducted a license premise check at All for Us, 3500 W. Fond du lac Av. The agents found Quest cards with PIN numbers written on them behind the counter. The agents also found an open pack of cigarettes behind the counter with cigarettes missing. The applicant was advised that lost quest cards must be turned in, single sales of cigarettes were illegal, and all cigarette invoices must be kept on premise.
- 2. On 02/04/2019 officers conducted follow up at 3500 W. Fond du lac Av, Lucky & Bill convenience store regarding sale of single beer cans. The officers observed a sign advertising single beer can sales and the cooler stocked with beer. The clerk, Sukhvir SINGH, stated his brother was the agent. He was informed of the fact the issued license stated "No single can sales" and that the agent had agreed to this provision. The clerk stated he would advise his brother.

3. On 09/07/2020 at 3:25pm officers investigated a Battery at 3500 W. Fond du lac. The applicant stated there was a subject in that has caused problems in the past, so he asked him to leave. The subject spit in the applicant's face. The subject left and the applicant followed him outside, where the suspect hit him in the head with a bottle.




City Concentration Map 3500 W Fond Du Lac Ave Milwaukee

- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)


- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
