State (2601 West State Street). This incident was later updated to a shooting. Investigation revealed the victim and suspects had been patrons inside the business. At bar close, both the victim and suspect exited when the suspect attempted to rob the victim. The victim was struck by shots fired by the suspect. The victim later died from his injuries. 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3.	On 05/11/2017 officers investigated an Armed Robbery which occurred at 2525 W. State St. The victim was a delivery driver who had just exited Rickey's on state, 2601 W. State St. when he was approached by two suspects, one that was armed with a firearm. The suspects did not obtain anything. The officers went to Rickey's to look for video surveillance. The business was cooperative and provided access to their video equipment.
1	On 10/27/2017 officers went to Ricky's on State 2601 W. State St. in an attempt to locate a

- 4. On 10/27/2017 officers went to Ricky's on State, 2601 W. State St, in an attempt to locate a burglary suspect who worked security at Ricky's. The subject was located at the door and was arrested without incident.
- 5. On 03/04/2018 officers were dispatched to Ricky's on State, 2601 W. State St, for a Sick or Injured Person. The caller stated a subject was unconscious. The officers were advised by security that a subject was taken to Mt. Sinai Hospital. The officers checked and found an intoxicated subject sleeping.

6. On 04/12/2019 at 1:09am officers were dispatched to a subject with gun call at Rickey's Lounge, 2601 W. State St. The officers spoke with the caller who stated she was in the bar with a friend she only knows as Steven. She stated there was a verbal altercation and Steven pushed her off her bar stool. Security then approached and Steven left the bar. the officers observed the security video which confirmed the callers statement.

7. On 07/19/2019 at 1:04am officers were dispatched to Rickey's on State, 2601 W. State St, for a Robbery complaint. The caller was uncooperative with the officers, refusing to give his name. The officers interviewed security who stated the subject was kicked out because he attempted to take money off the stage. As he was being escorted out he stated he was going to call the police. The robbery complaint was found to be baseless.

8. On 08/28/21 at 11:55pm, officers were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at Rickeys, 2601 W. State St. Officers were provided video surveillance from the manager. The video depicts two customers exit the bar and appear to be arguing outside of the location. One subject hands the other subject from the vehicle and they continue to argue at which time one subject pushes the other to the ground and gets on top, holding the other subject to the ground. The video then shows one subject get up and run away from the scene. Neither subject was located and management was cooperative.

On Friday, August 28, 11:55PM P.O. Andrew KEMPEN and I (Squad 3465) were dispatched to 2601 W. State St. for a subject with gun. Upon arrival we spoke to 2 patrons outside of the location regarding a domestic dispute that happened outside. P.O. KEMPEN spoke with Stacy M. WADUSKY (w/f, 2-6-75) who stated she is the manager of Rickey's on State. WADUSKY willingly allowed us to view video of this incident. Argument between Cameron M. MEADOWS (b/m, 12-13-87) and Jennifer K. BOYD (b/f, 1-1-83) started inside the business, but was not directly related to the business other than they were customers at the business prior to the incident starting.

Video from Rickey's (2601 W State St):

At 11:32 PM, MEADOWS exits the location with BOYD shortly afterwards. MEADOWS initially is leaning against his vehicle which is parked directly in front of the location on W State St. I could tell that they were talking but there is no audio to the video. At several points BOYD getting extremely close to MEADOWS while waving her hands around and possibly pointing her finger at his face. MEADOWS and BOYD end up at the driver's side rear of the vehicle where I observed MEADOWS appear to push BOYD down and then appear to push her again. The two then go back to the passenger side at which point BOYD is further away from the car and MEADOWS opens the car door. This happens a couple of times as when the door is open BOYD steps towards and MEADOWS turns around and stops what he was doing. MEADOWS appears to hand BOYD something however I was unable to determine what the item was. MEADOWS and BOYD then end up away from the car at which point you can see MEADOWS push BOYD down and get on top of her off the sidewalk. At this point it is hard to determine what is happening but MEADOWS does appear to be holding BOYD down. MEADOWS is then seen running east on W State St and BOYD appears to get up and grab two objects and move out of view on the west side of the building. BOYD then reappears and puts everything in her purse which was on the ground and walks to the front of the building.

P.O. KEMPEN was unable to recover the video from the location at this time due to technical difficulties with the system.

Myself and P.O. DOMBECK checked the field west of Rickey's and were unable to locate any objects.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 9/8/2021 at 9:30 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel — Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable — or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
