**LOCATION:** 4001 W. Calumet Rd.

**VIOLATION:** Cart return to storage

**INSPECTION:** Cart return citation was issued on June 17, 2021 for carts not returned to storage. Carts were stored at curbside / driveway approach.

- Information left at the property included the citation detailing location of cart storage violation.
- Instruction to move the carts to the proper storage location, the rear of driveway.
- Dates for next collections, garbage 6/22/21 & recycling 6/29/21.
- In addition to the citation was an additional notice, red card, informing violation must be corrected 3 days from date of inspection; carts must be returned to storage area no later than 10pm on collection date; and charges for first and repeat violation.

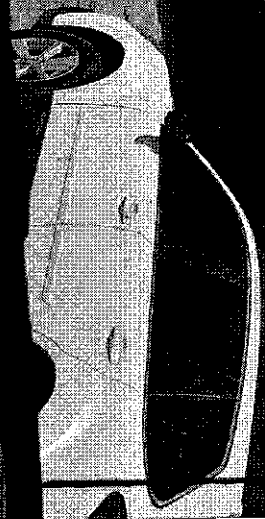
**REINSPECTION:** Reinspection occurred on June 23, 2021. One garbage can remained at the collection point - curbside. The recycling cart was properly stored at rear of driveway. The ordinance violation was not resolved and documented as violation not corrected.

**CONCLUSION:** Cart remained at collection point / curbside after June 22<sup>nd</sup> garbage collection. This is in violation of ordinance 79-5.5 which states carts must be returned to storage no later than 10pm on the day of collection.

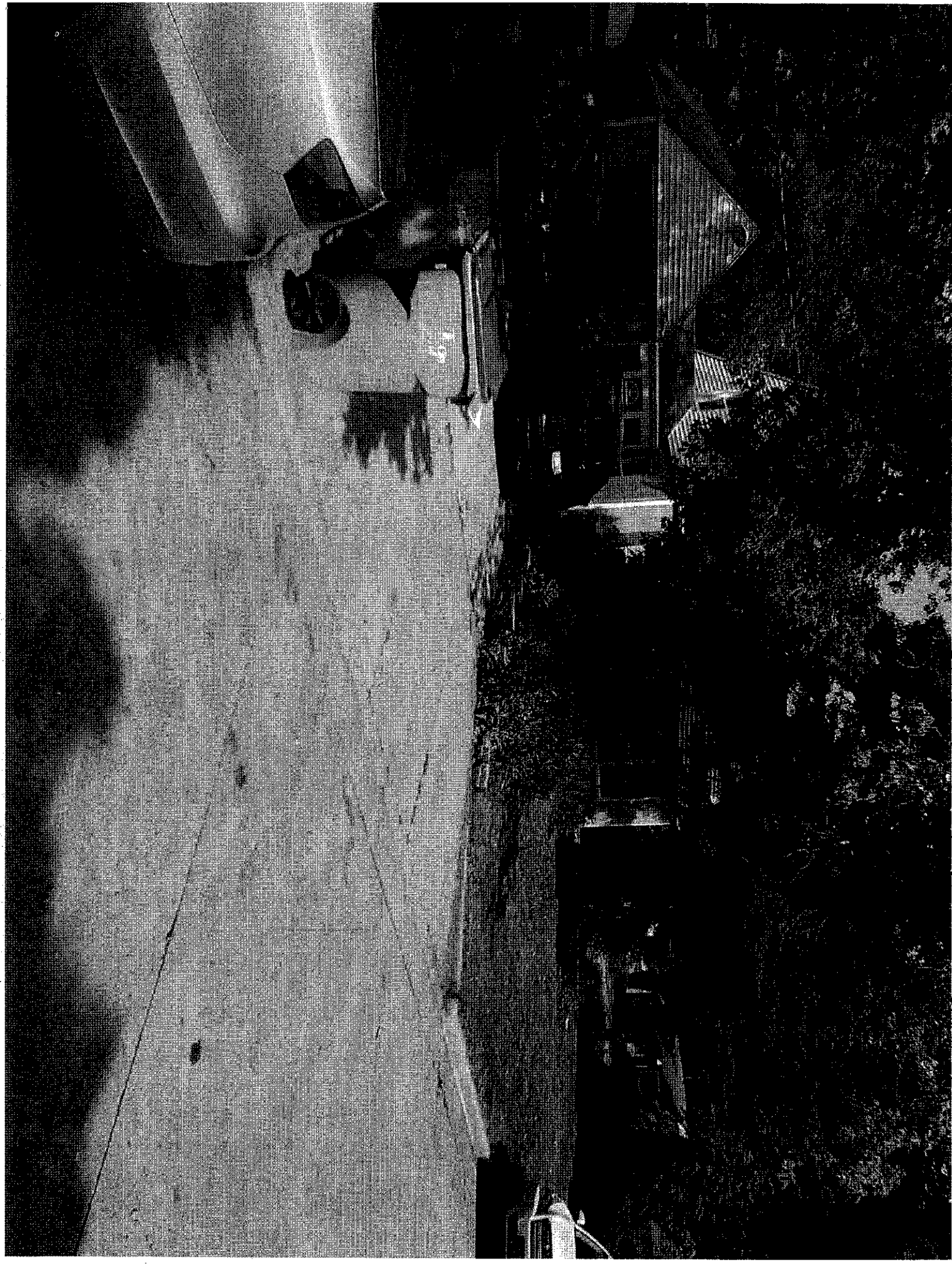

## **Solid Waste Regulations 79-5**

### **\*79-5. Location of Containers. 1. ON PREMISES.**

All containers used for solid waste disposal shall be stored on the premises. Where containers are kept within any enclosure, the enclosure shall have a door of sufficient size to allow the containers to be removed by sliding or rolling forward without being lifted.

2. **NEAR ALLEY.** Containers shall be stored immediately adjacent to the alley except where a premises does not have an alley, in which case containers shall be stored in the rear yard. If the rear yard may not be utilized for this purpose, the side yard may be used providing the containers are sited as conveniently as possible for servicing, as specified by the commissioner of public works. If the property owner can prove to the satisfaction of the commissioner that the rear or side yard cannot be used, the commissioner shall approve an alternate location prior to its use.

3. **ACCESSIBILITY.** It shall be the responsibility of the owners and tenants of every premises where solid waste is collected to provide a clear and unhindered path to all containers. The path shall be a width specified by the commissioner and shall be free of hindrances such as, but not limited to, large debris, vehicles, locked fences, animals, ice or 3 or more inches of snow. The surface of the path must be firm and nonhazardous.

(4.) **COLLECTION CHARGE.** If the location of the containers is more than 125 feet from the servicing vehicle or the containers are inconveniently located, the commissioner may charge for collection.

\* 5. **RETURN TO STORAGE LOCATION.** Owners and tenants of those premises serviced by the cart collection system, where carts are left at the alley line or curb line after servicing, shall return the carts to their proper storage location before 10 p.m. on the day they are serviced.

6. **ADDRESSES POSTED.** To facilitate collection services, the addresses of all residences and buildings shall be conspicuously posted at the front and rear or side of all properties so as to be easily seen and read, according to s. 113-2-5.

7. **NEW CONSTRUCTION OR SUBSTANTIAL IMPROVEMENT OF MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS.** Whenever a new multi-family dwelling of 5 units or more is constructed, a commercial building for 2 or more tenants is constructed, or a substantial improvement is made to an existing building containing or creating 5 or more dwelling units or
