This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 06/20/08 at 1:41 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3143 S Clement for a Subject With Weapon. Officers were given a description of the actor who was possibly armed and once inside the tavern, located the actor and found this patron was armed with a replica black handgun (toy gun) which was shoved in his front waist band. Police spoke to the bartender Jessica Lemmer who stated she did not see the gun but was told by patrons that the man had a gun. When asked by officers why Lemmer didn't call police she stated another bartender told her that this patron was always "strapped" and that he was "OK". A check found that Lemmer did not possess a valid bartenders license however there was another licensed bartender on scene. Police also spoke to the manager Kim Harteau who stated he also did not see a gun but was told by other patrons that a man was armed. A citation was issued to the suspect for **Disorderly Conduct**,

2. On 03/23/11 at 12:35 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3143 S Clement Avenue for a Loud Music complaint. Officers entered the bar and observed a patron at the bar smoking a cigarette. A citation was issued to the patron and police spoke with the bartender Rory Gorny who stated she was aware of the smoking ban. The music complaint was found baseless.

- 3. On 10/28/2013 the Wisconsin Department of Transportation revoked the applicant's drivers license for 9 months for Operating While Intoxicated.
- 4. On 10/24/2013 the applicant was cited at West Rosdale Avenue and South 6th Street in the city of Milwaukee for Refusal.

The caller, Mark Hanson, told officers that he had been at Swig's Bar and Grill (3143 South Clement Avenue) earlier in the evening and that another patron followed him out of business around 2:00am following a verbal altercation that took place inside the bar. The patron struck Hanson several times, rendering him unconscious. When he woke up, Hanson returned to the bar but the bartender's boyfriend told him they were closed. Hanson then drove himself to a Walgreen's for assistance. Milwaukee police incident report #150470012 filed.
- 7. On 01/04/2019 at 10:37pm officers were dispatched to a Sick and Injured at Swig's Pub, 3143 S Clement Av. The investigation revealed an employee, who was done working at 7:30pm, had stayed to socialize. The victim was not seen for 20 minutes and her boyfriend checked the bathroom and found her breathing but unresponsive. The victim was conveyed by ambulance to St Luke's Hospital. The victim was found to have overdosed. The officers spoke with Christopher BROWN, husband of the agent, who responded to the scene. BROWN stated the victim was an employee for three months and he was unaware of her drug activities.

The main level of the bar is raised from the street level. After the entrance you have to walk up a level of stairs to the main floor. As a result you cannot see the street from the interior and you cannot see the inside of the bar from the street level. The tavern does have a security monitor which monitors the exterior street entrance located at the bar.

This concludes my additional comments.


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City Concentration Map 3143 S Clement Ave, Milwaukee
