There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

### Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

I am writing concerning this 6/2/2021 10:20 AM Tavern License Renewal agenda item:

Renewal Applications for "GARE-BEAR'S" at 927 N 27TH St. (Expires 7/6/2021)

I am the , which operates a community center a block away from Gare-Bear's at 2819 W. Richardson Place and maintains the Neighborhood House Garden Park on the city-owned parcel immediately north of the Gare-Bear's front door.

I am writing to urge the City to require Gare Bear's staff to better monitor their clients on 27th Street. At virtually all hours of the day, patrons can be seen congregating outside the bar, creating an adverse impact on the immediate area. Further, while Gare Bear's staff have denied any connection to area litter, we also believe that the bar's clientele are responsible for some portion of the litter in the area.

We would like the bar to remain as a successful part of the commercial district, but hope for improved policing of the tavern's clientele by managers and staff if their license is renewed.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/15/2005 at 10:50 PM, P.O. Edmond and P.A. Woods (20 yrs old), entered the Gare-Bear's Tavern located at 927 N. 27th St. Pa Woods ordered 2 Miller Genuine draft beers from the Bartender on duty. Pa Woods was served w/o the bartender asking for proof of age. The Bartender was identified as B/M DANCY, Eddie M. (10/31/1958). Bartender was cited for Sale to Underage Person. Bartender stated he did not asked for ID, because "He Looked old enough."

2. On 04/10/08 at 12:52 am, Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check at 927 N 27th Street. Officers spoke to Corre Blount who was bartending. Blount was found not to have a bartenders license and stated he was working under the direction of another bartender, Harold Jenkins, who was licensed. Officers spoke with Jenkins and found his license was expired. Blount received a citation for Class D License Required and a routine wanted check revealed Jenkins had an outstanding warrant. Jenkins was placed into custody. The licensee Gary Lieske was not scene at the time of the violation but appeared in the tavern while officers were investigating. Police advised Lieske of the violations and cited Lieske for Class B Licensee's Responsibility.

3. On 05/10/08 at 2:00 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 927 N 27th Street for a Reckless Use complaint. Officers spoke to Gary Lieske who stated he had video surveillance of a subject who had discharged a handgun at 913 N 27th Street sometime after closing. Lieske advised officers that there were no problems in the tavern and that he would provide a copy of the video when he was able to download it. A report was filed.

4. On 05/28/09 at 2:55 pm, Milwaukee police were conducting Sales of Alcohol To Underage Persons and had a police aide who is under the age of 21 enter 927 N 27th Street in attempts to purchase alcohol. The bartender Joan Cross served the aide two beers without asking for any ID. The licensee Gary Lieske was issued a citation for Sale of Alcohol To Underage Person.

5. On 08/18/2013 Officers went to the business Gare-Bear's at 927 N 27th St and contacted the

applicant regarding Secondhand Dealer Notification. The applicant was given a copy of MCO chapter 92 regarding Secondhand Dealers. He signed an acknowledgement.

6. On 03/26/2014 at 2:10am Officers responded to Gare-Bears at 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St for a Battery Complaint. The investigation revealed the caller, Brian PETERSON, went into the tavern after last call and got upset that he could not get served alcohol. The bartender, Coree BLOUNT, asked PETERSON to leave and was walking to the door when PETERSON struck him to the face in an unprovoked attack. A physical altercation ensued until BLOUNT and several patrons were able to get PETERSON out of the bar. The applicant was on scene and provided the video tape of the incident, which confirmed the statement of the bartender. Battery report #14-085-0015 was filed but BLOUNT did not wish to prosecute.

7. On 09/13/2015 Milwaukee police investigated a battery/cutting at 927 North 27<sup>th</sup> Street (Gare Bear's). Video from the business indicates the victim of this offense was involved in an argument inside the bar. The argument continued outside, where the victim attempted to punch his assailant and both parties appear to arm themselves with pieces of broken glass they pick up from the ground. The victim received lacerations on his torso which required 33 stitches to close. Milwaukee police incident report #152560020 filed.

8. On 10/27/2017 Milwaukee police responded to a sick/injured person at 927 North 27<sup>th</sup> Street (Gare Bear's Tavern). Investigation revealed a patron of the bar was almost falling out of his chair and his head would go from side to side and front to back. This behavior occurred after the patron returned from using the bathroom, prompting the caller to believe the patron was on drugs. The officer discovered the patrons head would go limp and wobble from side to side. When the officer asked the patron if he had taken any drugs and how much he had to drink, the patron would return a blank stare and his head would fall limply forward. The patron was conveyed by ambulance to Mt. Sinai hospital where it was discovered his blood alcohol concentration was .285. Milwaukee police incident report #163010123 filed.

- 9. On 12/15/2017 officers were dispatched to a subject with gun complaint at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St. The officers received an update prior to arrival the call was a false alarm and there was no problem at the bar. They interviewed the maintenance man, Coree BLOUNT, who stated he did observe two subjects, who had been in the bar, arguing outside but no gun was observed. The officers did not locate the subjects.
- 10. On 01/22/2018 officers were dispatched to a shooting at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St. The officers found a subject lying on the sidewalk with a gunshot wound to the chest. The officers and MFD performed lifesaving measures but the subject was pronounced dead on the scene. The video surveillance showed the suspect exit the premises to smoke a cigarette. Outside the suspect bumped into the victim and after an argument he produced a handgun and shot the victim. The suspect then fled in his auto.
- 11. On 02/12/2018 at 9:02pm officers were dispatched to a subject with gun complaint at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St. The bartender, Luis RIOS, stated he let a subject, Isadore JEFFERSON, sit in the bar to "warm up". He did not serve him since he already appeared intoxicated. Later a replacement bartender asked JEFFERSON to make a purchase or leave the premise. JEFFERSON then threatened to "pop" the bartender and stated he had a gun in his backpack. No gun was found on JEFFERSON.

- 12. On 02/25/2018 officers were dispatched to a battery complaint at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St. The victim reported she was assaulted by her ex-boyfriend who was no longer on scene. While the officers checked the area the applicant called 911 to report a subject causing a disturbance. The officers returned and spoke with the applicant who stated a different subject who had been kicked out had returned and was refusing to leave. The applicant gave the subject a pizza to leave.
- 13. On 04/23/2018 a meeting was held regarding Gare Bear's. The applicant stated he will take action in abating the problems that occurred by posting No Loitering signs, No Weapons signs, and all Persons subject to search signs. He also stated he will have security posted at the door on Fridays and Saturdays by 04/28/2018.
- 14. On 04/28/2018 an officer went to Gare Bear's, 927 N. 27<sup>TH</sup> St, to conduct a licensed premise check. The officer found security at the door wanding patrons as they can in the tavern. The bartender stated security was just hired and checks every patron for weapons.

- 15. On 09/01/2019 at 12:32am officers were dispatched to a battery complaint at N. 26<sup>th</sup> St and W. Highland Bl. The officers located a subject who had been stabbed. The victim stated he was at Gare-Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St, when an argument started inside over missing money. The bar told all parties to leave the location. Once outside the fight continued in the parking lot of the Family Dollar. One of the subjects produced a kitchen knife and stabbed the victim on the right side. The subject fled on foot. The officers went to Gare-Bears and spoke with the bartender, who stated he was the only one working and did not see anything. The bartender stated the applicant was the only person that could access the video system. The officer spoke with the applicant by phone and he stated he could not come to the bar that night but an officer could come in the morning to view the video.
- 16. On 09/01/2019 at 8:19pm officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject call at Gare-Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St. The officers spoke with the applicant who stated there was an unknown subject kicking his door. The applicant pointed out the subject who was standing down the street. The officers attempted to speak to the subject but found he was deaf. The subject left with his brother and was told to not return.
- 17. On 12/23/2019 at 12:22am officers were dispatched to Gare-Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St, for a subject with gun call. The officers spoke with the security guard, who stated a female came in and had a gun held at her side. He stated he had kicked this female out last week and she came back and threatened to kill him. The subject left in a vehicle prior to the arrival of the police.
- 18.On 03/17/2020 at 12:34am officers conducted a licensed premise check at Gare-Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St., regarding the recently announced emergency closure order. The staff stated they understood the rules and no violations were observed.

- 19. On 10/21/20 at 10:54pm, officers were flagged down by the bartender of Gare Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St. Officers were advised a subject had entered the bar armed with a pellet rifle, causing customers to fear for their safety. The bartender advised the subject multiple times to leave the bar, however the subject refused. The bartender then began hitting the rifle with a Louisville Slugger bat until the subject dropped it. The subject was conveyed to the hospital for a small laceration to his finger and subsequently arrested for Disorderly Conduct while Armed. No violations were found and the business was cooperative.
- 20. On 12/27/20 at 11:35pm, officers were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St. Officers were advised a subject became upset inside the bar and made statements to shoot up the bar. The subject was then asked to leave the bar and the employee locked the door so the subject could not re-enter. The subject then began throwing objects at the door and windows. The subject was issued a citation for the violation. No violations were found and the employee was cooperative.
- 21. On 12/29/20 at 7:59pm, officers were dispatched to an Entry at Gare Bears, 927 N. 27<sup>th</sup> St. Officers were advised by the employee a patron entered the bar causing a disturbance, therefore was kicked out and the door was locked to prevent re-entry. The subject then threw a garbage can at the door and attempted to get back in. Officers checked the area, however, were unable to locate the subject. No violations were found and employees were cooperative.

#### **ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- Spoke with the new Licensee who stated he wasn't sure if he would sign the "Standing Complaint" form because if police generate their own calls it looks bad when attempting to renew Licenses. The owner wasn't opposed to it but will wait until later for this form to happen.
- Licensee stated a cover charge, ID Scanner, metal detector and dress code may be used in the future but as of now, will only have the age restriction.
- Licensee stated they will have 1-15 employees on scene but a minimum of 1 at all times other than the licensee.
- Licensee stated the upstairs to the location is an apartment building and believes they are fully occupied.

#### Recommendation:

- Licensee to get no loitering signs on the location.
- Get loading zone to clear up parking in front of the location which may eliminate vehicle loitering and persons standing in front of the location
- Take the signs out of the windows because one can't see inside the location at all.
  - o Also can see outside the location from the interior either.




### City Concentration Map 927 N 27th St





