

An ordinance adopting the Citywide Policy Plan and 13 Area Comprehensive Plans as the City's Comprehensive Plans.

Whereas, Section 66,1001(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes stipulates that, beginning on January 1, 2010, if a local governmental unit engages in any of various specified actions (e.g., subdivision regulation and zoning ordinances), those actions shall be consistent with that lacal governmental unit's comprehensive plan; and

Whereas, Over the past decade, the Department of City Development has prepared 13 Area Comprehensive Plans that together encompass the entire geographic extent of the City of Milwaukee and that each contain all of the comprehensive plan elements required by s. 66,1001(2), Wis. Stats, and

Whereas, Copies of each of these Area Comprehensive Plans—are attached to and made a part of this Common Council file; and

Whereas, Each of the Area Comprehensive Plans have been approved by both the City Plan Commission and the Common Council; and

Whereas, The Department of City Development has also prepared a Citywide Policy Plan that is to be part of the City's Comprehensive Plan and has been approved by both the City Plan Commission and Common Council; and

Whereas, A capy of the Citywide Policy Plan is also attached to and

has been approved by Bolli Marcommission and Common Council; and Whereas, A capy of the Citywide Policy Plan is also attached to and made a part of this file; and Whereas, Section 66.1001(4), Wis.
