The federal Preventive Health and Health Services (PHHS) Block Grant provides funding to address health problems, prevent diseases and promote health in Wisconsin. In 2016, Wisconsin received approximately \$3 million through this grant to fund health programs statewide. The City of Milwaukee Health Department is allocated around \$60,000 each year. In 2021-2022, the MHD will use these funds to meet the following objective:

- 1. By September 30, 2022, the City of Milwaukee Health Department will be better positioned to apply for PHAB accreditation.
- 2. By September 30, 2022, the City of Milwaukee Health Department will be closer to the complete implementation of a department-wide Electronic Health Record.
