8. On 07/01/2018 at 12:22am officers were dispatched to an armed robbery at 2691 S 6<sup>th</sup> St. The investigation revealed the victim was at the bar and left with a subject he met at the bar to purchase narcotics. The victim was shot buy the suspect at 700 W. Cleveland. The applicant was on scene and cooperative with the investigation.

- 9. On 04/10/21 at 2:01am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2691 S. 6<sup>th</sup> Street for a shooting complaint. Investigation revealed that a fight erupted in the establishment and one subject was shot. The victim was conveyed to a hospital in a van where two spent casings were found in the interior. There were also 24 spent shell casings found in the rear parking lot and in the front of the tavern. A vehicle in the rear parking lot had bullet holes in the windshield and there was blood on the bar entrance door. Officers forced entry to the tavern and found it in disarray with a lot of blood throughout the interior, but the tavern was empty.
- 10. On 04/11/21 at 11:03pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 2691 S. 6<sup>th</sup> Street. The officer found that the only bartender inside the establishment did not have a valid bartenders license and the owner was not on the property. The officer will be issuing citations to the bartender and the applicant.
- 11. On 05/04/21 at 7:06pm, Milwaukee Police, along with the Department of Revenue, conducted a license premise check at 2691 S. 6<sup>th</sup> Street. The Department of Revenue Agent seized 123 bottles from the tavern because the applicant could not provide receipts and observed bottles with retail purchase stickers on them. The agent also noticed possible signs of refilling liquor bottles and told the applicant that he needed alcoholic beverage purchase invoices on site.

were dispatched to the address of 2691 S. 6th St. La Pasadita Bar which is in the City and County of Milwaukee WI. to assist squad 2325 (PO Roberto SANCHEZ and PO Jordan YOUNG) on their shooting investigation.

Upon arrival, several squads on scene located a total of 24 spent casings in the rear parking lot, as well as in front of the bar on the sidewalk. Blood was also located in the parking lot an on the Bar entrance door. Officers also observed a 2004 Gray Acura, T1 bearing WI plates 508-SNE VIN: 19UUA66264A073224 which was located in the rear parking lot with several bullet holes on through the windshield.

Officers on scene also observed blood on the bar entrance door and forced entry inside and found the inside to be in total disarray with a lot of blood throughout the interior of the bar. The bar was empty with no one injured inside. There was blood in the fenced in patio area and the fence itself appeared to have been manually broken down to allow patrons to escape.

The victim from the shooting was later identified as Nicole RIVERA-BETANCOURT (W/F, 5/20/1997 of 1515 S 36th St), who arrived at St Francis with a GSW to her right armpit. Her wound was severe and she was intubated before she could be interviewed. She is expected to survive.

A witness of the incident later identified as Jesus M QUINONES-CARRASQUILLO (W/M, 7/29/1998 of 1556 W Mitchell St #4), told Officers that he had been at the bar with a friend and the victim, who is his ex-girlfriend. QUINONES-CARRASQUILLO stated that he got into a fight with a few guys in the bar who were harassing him for being Puerto Rican. QUINONES-CARRASQUILLO stated that during the fight he heard gunshots and fled the area. QUINONES-CARRASQUILLO stated once the gunshots stopped he returned to the bar and found RIVERA-BETANCOURT shot and he placed her in his friends Honda Odyssey and dropped them both off at the hospital and then left. The witness was released from the scene after being interviewed.

Officers were later able to locate the van at the address of 1308 S.17th St. and the owner. The van had blood inside and had a total of three spent casings in the interior. The owner gave consent to search her home and Officers located a suitcase belonging to the above witness that contained approximately 200 grams of heroin.

A search warrant was later drafted and executed due to the owner or bar employees returning back to the scene to recover the video surveillance and evidence.

This concludes this report.

This report is typed by PO Oscar ESPITIA assigned to District Two, Late Power Shift and Squad 2573.

On Monday April 11th, 2021 at approximately 11:00 PM my partner PO RAMIREZ and I conducted a tavern check at the location of 2691 S. 6th St. (La Pasadita Bar). Upon arrival I observed an unarmed security guard who was later identified as Roberto R. LOZANO-LOPEZ (W/M, 06/07/72) standing by the entrance door. LOZANO-LOPEZ asked the bartender who was later identified as Vividiana PEREZ-HERNANDEZ (W/F, 04/10/86), to turn the music down. I asked PEREZ-HERNANDEZ if the owner of the tavern was at the location. LOPEZ-HERNANDEZ stated the owner who was later identified as Luis LOPEZ-GONZALEZ (W/M, 01/20/71), was at his other tavern located at 1993 S. Muskego Ave. (La Hamaka Bar). I asked LOPEZ-HERNANDEZ if I could see the liquor license and her bartender license. I observed the liquor license hanging on a wall behind the bar. The license was issued to Luis LOPEZ-GONZALEZ and the address of 2691 S. 6th St. LOPEZ-HERNANDEZ stated she left her bartender license at her residence.

I conducted a search on City Hall license search and LIRA website for LOPEZ-HERNANDEZ and was unable to find a bartender license issued to her.

I attempted to locate LOPEZ-GONZALEZ at 1993 S. Muskego Ave. but the tavern was closed and no answer at the door.

I will be filling citations to LOPEZ-HERNANDEZ for not having a bartender license and LOPEZ-GONZALEZ for operating a tavern without a license bartender.

The second secon On Tuesday, May 4, 2021 at approximately 7:06 PM, we went to 2691 S. 6th St. (La Pasadita Bar) to assist the Department of Revenue Special Agent Rick UHLIG with a license premise check. Squad 2510 (SGT Guadalupe RAMIREZ-CERVANTES) responded to monitor.

Special Agent UHLIG met with the owner/agent Luis L. GONZALEZ (W/M, 1-20-71) to check the receipts/records of his alcohol purchases.

GONZALEZ showed current receipts/records to Special Agent UHLIG of beer purchases from a business that distributes alcohol/liquor to other businesses/taverns.

GONZALEZ was unable to present current receipts/records of liquor bottles from a business that distributes alcohol/liquor other to businesses/taverns. The most recent records/receipts that GONZALEZ had in his tavern office was from 2017-2018.

Special Agent UHLIG observed a bottle with Pick N Save sticker and another liquor bottle with a local liquor store sticker, which are not stores a tavern can purchase liquor from.

Special Agent UHLIG and the other Department of Revenue special agent seized 93 open liquor bottles and 30 sealed liquor bottles from inside the tavern.

Special Agent UHLIG noticed possible signs of refilling liquor bottles in the bar area of the tavern.

The Department Revenue special agents advised GONZALEZ that he needed to have the alcohol beverage purchase invoices on site and available for inspections.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 9/28/2021 at 2:35 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
