4. On 10/23/10 at approximately 2:25am officers were at Thurman's 15 at 1731 N. Arlington Pl. Officers observed that there were 8-12 patrons still seated at the tavern with drinks. Officers heard patrons inside say "It's the cops. Let's go." and while attempting to gain entry, observed the tavern staff rush everyone inside out the back door. After the tavern was empty the staff unlocked the door and allowed the officers inside.

The tavern staff denied to the officers that patrons were in the tavern after hours. When asked to view the license, the staff retrieved it from the floor behind the bar.

The bartender on duty (Daisy Vasquez) did not have a valid bartender's license. When asked who was on scene licensed to serve alcohol, she stated "No one".

Officers observed Milwaukee Fire Department personnel performing CPR on a subject who suffered multiple stab wounds and was now on the south curb of the street approximately 40 feet from the intersection of North Arlington Place and North Pulaski Street. Milwaukee Fire Department personnel continued to conduct CPR on this subject until he was pronounced dead on the scene. Investigation revealed this subject had earlier been inside Thurman's when he became involved in an altercation with two other tavern patrons. The incident moved outside where witness's state they observed a fight before observing the victim collapse near the curb. Milwaukee police incident report #162420010 filed.

- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
