On Thursday, February 11th, 2021, at approximately 10:32 PM, while on patrol, squad 3241, PO Margaret DEVITO and I were dispatched to 2033 W Brown St, located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI, to investigate a reckless use of a weapon.

Upon arrival we located the caller/victim Joe H MALLORY (B/M 01-08-73). MALLORY stated at approximately 9:58 PM he was taking garbage out at his work "Village Valet Dry Cleaners" located at 3200 W North ave, located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

MALLORY stated at this time a light green 80-90s model jeep pulled up to the location. MALLORY stated a 30-39 years of age Black Male, Black hair, wearing a grey knit cap, grey north face style jacket, grey stone washed pants, and tennis shoes exit the vehicle. MALLORY stated he had a small black semi automatic handgun holstered in a black fabric holstered outside the waistband, located in the 2:00 position.

MALLORY stated the subject inquired where his clothes had been. MALLORY stated that they had been thrown out because they had been left in their storage area for approximately a week. MALLORY stated the subject told him "Mother fuckers don't want me clowning" and "We're gonna have to fight or shoot". MALLORY stated the subject told him that he would come to shoot up the store in the morning.

MALLORY stated this caused him to fear for the safety of the occupants in the store and call the police.

MALLORY stated he has seen the subject before and is known to work at the "Family Dollar Store" located at 2214 N 35th St, and a corner store at N 40th St and W Lisbon Ave.

MALLORY stated the laundromat he works at has external cameras that would have video footage of the incident.

MALLORY was given a PV-17 and a community contact card.

I notified Village Valet manager Raniyah N BROWN (B/F 06-20-01) of the incident.

On Monday, May 3rd, 2021, at approximately 9:42 PM, while on patrol, PO Dexter LEE and I were dispatched to 3200 W North Ave, located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI, to investigate a subject with weapon.

Upon arrival, we spoke to the caller/ employee Joe H MALLORY (B/M 01-08-73). MALLORY stated there had been a customer described as a black male, approximately 20 years of age, 508, 200 pounds, wearing shorts, and a navy trench coat, playing a gambling machine inside the laundry mat. MALLORY stated the subject went outside and came back in with Green handled cutting sheers. MALLORY stated he told him he lost all of his rent money to the machine and proceeded to cut the lock from the first and last of the 3 machines. MALLORY stated he attempted to tell him to stop 2-3 times. MALLORY stated the subject took the front panels of the machines containing the money storage and exited through the west exit. MALLORY stated the subject squeezed through the North fence and fled in an unknown direction.

PO LEE and I surveyed the area and located the panels on the north side loading docks with the money units broken. We recovered the panels and notified the manager Alvin D NELSON (B/M 08-24-68) who arrived on scene at approximately 10:00 PM.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
