



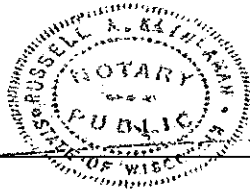

levying of assessments and
construction of assessable public
improvement projects at various
locations and appropriating funds for
these purposes with the City cost of
these projects approved by this reso-
lution is estimated to be \$16,400 for
a total estimated cost of \$16,400.

Whereas, The Common Council of
the City of Milwaukee adopted
preliminary resolutions, determining
it necessary and in the public
interest to construct and levy special
assessments for the following
improvements:

7th Aldermanic District

N. 53rd St. - W. Congress St. to
W. Lincoln Creek Dr. (ST211210232)
Install traffic calming speed hump(s).
(Assessable Reconstruction Paving
Fund - \$4,500; Nonassessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund -
\$2,600). The total estimated cost of
this project including the requested
amount is \$7,100. This project is
anticipated to be completed during
the 2021 construction season.

8th Aldermanic District

W. Becher St. - 2100 block
(ST211210171) Install traffic calming
speed hump(s). (Assessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund -
\$6,100; Nonassessable
Reconstruction Paving Fund -
\$3,200). The total estimated cost of
this project including the requested
amount is \$9,300. This project is
anticipated to be completed during
the 2021 construction season.

Further Resolved, That the projects do not involve any parcels of agricultural land which are eligible for deferred special assessments under the provisions of Section 14.30 of the Milwaukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works is authorized to use the funding as specified in the above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That projects: N. 53rd St. (ST211210232) and W. Becher St. (ST211210171) will be billed after January 1, 2023, but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed.
