Remove and replace current downspouts with new round down spout. Disconnect from storm sewer and reroute downspouts and slope of gutters. South running gutters will have 2 down spouts one on east side and one on west side. North running gutters will continue to have 1

down spout and will be moved 6" east of current location. Furnish and install 3/4" cedar fascia- white -eaves only-Furnish and install 3/8" thick fir wood soffit- painted white

Crown moulding on eave edge only -white- similar style
