



- 63.3% Single Dose



Vaccination Trends Over Time By Age Group


Percent of City of Milwaukee Residents with One or More Vaccination Doses By Age Group




CITY VACCINE MANDATE

- Pfizer authorized under EUA
 - 2 Dose Regimen
 - Oct. 29 FDA
 - Nov. 2 CDC (ACIP and Director)
- Will begin when:
 - CDC releases clinical guidance
 - WI DHS updates and distributes Immunization Program Policy and Procedure Manual
