WHO TO CALL FOR NEIGHBORS IN NEED

Partners for Home is the coordinating agency for the Atlanta Continuum-of-Care (CoC), a local collaborative that coordinates housing, services and funding for families and individuals experiencing homelessness. As a partner agency, the PAD Initiative works closely with the CoC to contribute to the mission of ending homelessness in Atlanta. These are the resources we recommend for individuals in need of assistance in the City of Atlanta.

Call 211 for the United Way of Greater Atlanta Helpline | M-F, 8am - 7pm

Call 211 for information that connects people to essential health and human services resources.

Call 311 for the Policing Alternatives and Diversion Initiative | M-F, 7am - 7pm

Call 311 for non-emergency assistance related to mental health, substance use or extreme poverty within the City of Atlanta. A response team may be dispatched to the area to provide assistance. If located outside the city lines, call (404) 546-0311.

Call 911 for Emergency Assistance | 24 hrs/ 7 Days a Week

Call 911 for medical emergencies or instances that require response from a police officer, EMT or firefighter. A response team will be dispatched to the area to provide assistance.

Call 911 for the Grady Mobile Crisis Response One Team | M-Sat, 10am - 10pm

Call 911 for someone having a severe mental health crisis that is at risk to themselves or others. Ask for the Grady 7170 Mobile Psychiatric Team. A response team may be dispatched to the area if available.

Call 800-415-7225 for the Georgia Crisis and Access Line | 24 hrs/ 7 Days a Week

Call 800-415-7225 for people experiencing challenges with mental health, drugs, alcohol, or developmental disabilities. A response team may be dispatched to the area if needed.

Call 404-215-6600 for Coordinated Entry through Gateway Center | M-F, 9:00am - 4:00pm

Call 404-215-6600 for people experiencing homelessness who need to get assessed for housing via the Coordinated Entry System. Coordinated Entry is a streamlined way to assess and connect people to a housing intervention.
