PASSAGE OF THE FOLLOWING:

2. <u>060516</u> A substitute ordinance relating to parking controls in various Aldermanic Districts.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 101-23-3 of the Code relating to No Parking is amended by striking the following:

"On the east side of North 4th Street from West McKinley Avenue to a point 160 feet north at any time"

"On the west side of North Industrial Road from a point 2982 feet north of West Mill

Road to a point 70 feet north thereof"

"On the west side of North Industrial Road from a point 3149 feet north of West Mill Road to a point 30 feet north thereof"

"On the west side of North Industrial Road from a point 3204 feet north of West Mill Road to a point 60 feet north thereof"

Part 2. Section 101-23-3 of the Code relating to No Parking is amended by adding the following:

On the south side of West Wells Street from North 19th Street to a point 50 feet west

On the south side of West Wells Street from North 25th Street to a point 50 feet west

On the east side of North Industrial Road from a point 3090 feet north of West Mill Road to a point 450 feet north thereof

On the west side of North Industrial Road from a point 3190 feet north of West Mill Road to a point 440 feet north thereof

On the east side of North 12th Street from a point 260 feet north of West Vine Street to a point 100 feet north thereof

On the west side of North 12th Street from a point 370 feet north of West Vine Street to a point 100 feet north thereof

Part 3. Section 101-23-4-b of the Code relating to Half-Hour Parking is amended by striking the following:

"On the north side of West Norwich Avenue from the west curb line of South Howell Avenue to the first north-south alley, except Saturday and Sunday"

Part 4. Section 101-23-4-d of the Code relating to Two-Hour Parking is amended by striking the following:

"On South Muskego Avenue from West Becher Street to West Grant Street"

Part 5. Section 101-23-4-d of the Code relating to Two-Hour Parking is amended by adding the following:

On the west side of South Muskego Avenue from West Becher Street to West Grant Street

On the north side of West Norwich Avenue from South Howell Avenue west to the alley

On the north side of East Pittsburgh Avenue from South Barclay Street to a point 110 feet west

On South Barclay Street from East Pittsburgh Avenue to East Florida Street

Part 6. Section 101-27-9 of the Code relating to Night Parking Exceptions is amended by adding the following:

On East Menomonee Street from North Milwaukee Street to North Jackson Street

On North Jefferson Street from East Erie Street to East Chicago Street

On North Jackson Street from East Corcoran Avenue to East Chicago Street

Part 1. Section 101-7-2 of the Code relating to Designation of Non-intersection Crosswalk is amended by adding the following:

On North Industrial Road at a point 3190 feet north of West Mill Road

On North Industrial Road at a point 3454 feet north of West Mill Road

On North 12th at a point 360 feet north of West Vine Street

Part 2. Section 101-11-1 of the Code relating to No Left Turns is amended by adding the following:

On South 6th Street at West National Avenue when displayed southbound

Part 3. Section 101-12-4 of the Code relating to Mandatory Turns is amended by adding the following:

On West McKinley Avenue at North Old World Third eastbound

Part 4. Section 101-13-8 of the Code relating to School Speed 20 MPH is amended by adding the following:

On West Wells Street from North 18th Street to North 19th Street

Part 5. Section 101-16-1 of the Code relating to Stop signs is amended by adding the following:

On West Glendale Avenue at North 78th Street

On East Vollmer Avenue at South Ellen Street

Part 6. Section 101-18-1 of the Code relating to No Heavy Traffic is amended by adding the following:

On North 32nd Street at West Canal Street northbound

5. <u>060709</u> Resolution relative to acceptance and funding of a Juvenile Accountability Block

Grant from the State of Wisconsin, Office of Justice Assistance.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the State of Wisconsin, Office of Justice Assistance for the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant to operate the School Safety Program; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant from 07/01/2006 to 06/30/2007 would cost \$88,509 of which \$8,851 would be provided by the city and \$79,658 would be provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Community Development Grants Administration shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Common Council File 030712; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2006 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects, the following amounts for the program titled: "Juvenile Accountability Block Grant - School Safety Program":

Project/Grt Fund Org Program BY Subclass Account GR0000600000 0150 9990 0001 0000 R999 000600

Project Amount Grantor Share \$79,658

- 2. Create the necessary Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project/Grant levels: budget against these Project/Grant values the amount required under the grant agreement; and
- 3. Establish the necessary City Share Project Values; and, be it

Further Resolved, That these funds are budgeted for the Community Development Grants Administration which is authorized to:

- 1. Expend from the amount budgeted for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;
- 2. Expend from the 2006 grant budget funds for specific items of equipment.
