The widget will allow visitors of the City’s website to confirm or update their voter registration without having to leave the City’s website. Furthermore, the widget will allow the City to access voter registration status and capture entered data so that the Election Commission can measure success of implementation. In addition, the agreement entitles the City to any updates, revisions or upgrades of the services or the documentation provided by the Vote Movr Widget.

Whereas, WI Civic Duty, Inc. has agreed to licensed use of the Vote Movr Widget, provided by PF Data, LLC, by the City ; and

Whereas, The Vote Movr widget will allow visitors of the City’s website to confirm or update their voter registration without having to leave the City’s website; and

Whereas, The widget will allow the City to access voter registration status and capture entered data so that the Election Commission can measure success of implementation; and

Whereas, The agreement entitles the City to any updates, revisions or upgrades of the services or the documentation provided by the Vote Movr Widget; now, therefore, be it
