- 4. Share valuable insights, experiences and lessons learned among participating cities and towns.
- 5. Recognize, publicize and celebrate the work of cities and towns that have joined the Partnership for Inclusive Communities.

Whereas, A growing number of cities across the United States have joined the Partnership for Inclusive Communities to build inclusive communities through committed efforts to increase citizen participation and engagement, while promoting equal opportunity and fairness; and
