Substitute resolution approving levying of assessments and construction of assessable public improvement projects at various locations.

This resolution confirms the report of the Commissioner of Public Works, as modified by the Common Council Committee, on projects for which Public Hearings have been held. The resolution authorizes the levying of special assessments and directs the installation and construction of said public improvements.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions, determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct and levy special assessments for the following improvements:

1st and 7th Aldermanic Districts

N. 35th St. Structure over the Lincoln Creek (BR32000501/ST32001801) (2100-11-70/2100-11-00) File Number 991756: Bridge rehabilitation, replace curb and gutter and sidewalk and driveway approaches where needed, sodding, and grading. State or Federal Funds -- \$90,000; Nonassessable State Aid Fund -- \$30,000; Assessable State Aid Fund -- \$1,500; State/Federal Grantor Paving Fund -- \$15,000; State or Federal Structure Funds -- \$505,000; State/Federal Grantor Structure Fund -- \$75,500 Nonassessable State Aid Structure Fund -- \$150,000) These funds are to be transferred to the construction accounts BR32000510 and ST32001810.

5th Aldermanic District

W. Chambers St.- N. 80th St. to N. 84th St. (ST211040101) File Number 030635: Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where needed, sodding, and grading. (Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$7,000; Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$167,900)

W. Silver Spring Dr. (South Side) - N. Lovers Lane Rd. to N. 118th St. (ST210020104) File Number 020483 : Install concrete walk, replace curb and gutter where needed, sodding, and grading. (Assessable New Paving Fund -- \$7,300; Nonassessable New Paving Fund -- \$30,000)

Whereas, The report of the Commissioner of Public Works has been filed with the City Clerk; and

Whereas, Notices have been sent to all interested persons and public hearings held; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Commissioner of Public Works' Report, as amended at said Public Hearing, is approved and the properties therein identified are benefited; and, be it

Further Resolved, That said Commissioner of Public Works is authorized and directed to proceed with said work in accordance with said report pursuant to Section 66.0703 and any other pertinent sections of the Wisconsin Statutes and in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper departments take such action as is required of them to assess the abutting or adjacent properties and collect such assessment in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the projects do not involve any parcels of agricultural land which are eligible for deferred special assessments under the provisions of Section 14.30 of the Milwaukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Engineer and the Commissioner of Public Works are hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the State of Wisconsin, Department of

Transportation for the City to undertake construction management duties on the following project: N. 35th St. Structure over the Lincoln Creek (BR32000501/ST32001801) (2100-11-70/2100-11-00); and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Engineer is authorized and directed to approve and make periodic payments to the State of Wisconsin, Department of Transportation after receipt of invoices from said State for the City's share of the costs for said project:

N. 35th St. Structure over the Lincoln Creek (BR32000501/ST32001801) (2100-11-70/2100-11-00); and, be it

Further Resolved, That upon the completion of project: N. 35th St. Structure over the Lincoln Creek (BR32000501/ST32001801) (2100-11-70/2100-11-00) and a determination of the actual cost(s), it is understood that if the City of Milwaukee's share is less than the amount previously paid, the difference will be refunded to said City; and, be it

Further Resolved, That projects; N. 35th St. Structure over the Lincoln Creek (BR32000501/ST32001801) (2100-11-70/2100-11-00), W. Chambers St. (ST211040101), and W. Silver Spring Dr. (ST210020104) will be billed after January 1, 2006, but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed.
