An ordinance relating to deferred special assessments.

115-44-3-b am

Currently, the maximum annual household income for an applicant to be eligible for a deferred special assessment is \$20,000. Under this ordinance, this maximum annual household income will be increased to \$25,000. This amount was last changed in 2004, from \$17,000 to \$20,000.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 115-44-3-b of the code is amended to read:

**115-44. Deferred Special Assessments.**

**3. ELIGIBILITY.** b. Have a maximum annual household income of ~~[[ \$20,000 ]]~~ >> \$25,000 <<.
