This ordinance increases from \$60 to \$180 the minimum forfeiture for violating any parking regulation for physically disabled persons specified in s. 346.505, Wis. Stats.,

and adopted by s. 101-3 of the code.

Part 1. Section 101-34-2-i of the code is amended to read:

101-34. Stipulation Procedure: Nonmoving Traffic Violations.
