THE CHAIR

Substitute resolution authorizing the Milwaukee Police Department to accept Asset Forfeiture Equitable Sharing funds from the United States Postal Service for official use in furthering law enforcement objectives.

Whereas, Common Council File Number 930380 establishes the City's procedural guidelines regarding the receipt, appropriation and expenditure of contributions; and

Whereas, The United States Postal Service has remitted funds in the amount of \$10,960.71 to the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD), which represents the City's equitable share of seized assets; and

Whereas, Federal regulations require that these funds be accounted for separately from all other contributions or funds, and that the funds are to be used for law enforcement purposes; and

Whereas, The Police Department intends to use these proceeds to fund the following items submitted in its 2000 Asset Forfeiture Plan, referenced in Common Council File 991443:

Cellular Phone Usage -- \$10,960.71;

now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Milwaukee Police Department is authorized to accept and expend up to \$10,960.71 from the U.S. Postal Service for law enforcement purposes, in accordance with established City policies and procedures for acceptance of contributions; and, be it

Further Resolved, That upon receipt and deposit of these funds, the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to establish a special account within the Police Department's budget for the expenditure of this contribution; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer appropriations and estimated revenue from the Contribution

Fund - General, Account number 0001-2110-0001-D001-006300, and the estimated revenue account for Contributions, Account Number 0001-2110-0001-009850 to the Police Department's special account 0001-3310-0001-Dxxx-006300 and the Police Department's estimated revenue account 0001-3310-0001-009850.
