SUBSTITUTE 1

THE CHAIR

A substitute charter ordinance relating to inclusion of a trustee as beneficiary of an ordinary death benefit under the employes' retirement system.

36-05-10-a-0 am

This charter ordinance amends s. 36-05-10-a-0 to include a trustee as beneficiary of an ordinary death benefit under the employes' retirement system.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1: Section 36-05-10-a-0 of the Charter is amended to read as follows:

## 36-05. Benefits.

- **10.** ORDINARY DEATH BENEFIT.
- a. Beneficiary. Upon the receipt of proper proofs of death of a member in active service which is not the result of an accident in the actual performance of duty as defined in sub. 5, his >><u>or her</u><< accumulated contributions shall be paid to such person,>><u>or such trustee</u>,<<if any, as he >><u>or</u> <u>she</u><< has nominated by written designation duly executed and filed with the board prior to his >>or her<< death, otherwise to his >><u>or her</u><< estate, and if such member has completed one or more years of creditable service there shall be paid in addition a lump sum benefit of ½ the final average salary of such deceased member. [[<u>The beneficiary</u>]]>><u>Such person designated by the</u> <u>member</u><<may elect to receive the amount payable as follows:</p>

Part 2. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect 60 days after its passage and publication, unless within such 60 days a referendum petition is filed as provided in s. 66.0101(5), Wis. Stats., in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
