Substitute resolution approving, ratifying and confirming the memorandum of understanding covering wages, hours and conditions of employment agreement between the city negotiating team and the Milwaukee Police Association, Local #21, I.U.P.A., AFL-CIO for the period of January 1, 2004, through December 31, 2006.

- Analysis -

The purpose of this resolution is to confer common council approval, ratification and

confirmation on a memorandum of understanding between the City of Milwaukee negotiating team and the Milwaukee Police Association, Local #21, I.U.P.A., AFL-CIO, covering wages, hours and conditions of employment for the time period commencing January 1, 2004, through December 31, 2006.

Whereas, The agreement between the city negotiating team and the Milwaukee Police Association, Local #21, I.U.P.A., AFL-CIO, for the time period commencing January 1, 2004, through December 31, 2006, has been reduced to writing; and

Whereas, The memorandum of understanding embodying the agreement reached by the parties, a copy of which is attached to Common Council File No. 031029 and incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length, was executed by the parties subject to ratification by the Common Council; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the agreement between the city negotiating team and the Milwaukee Police Association, Local #21, I.U.P.A., AFL-CIO, is approved; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the city negotiating team is hereby authorized and directed to reduce the agreement to a formal contract between the union and the city; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper city officials are directed to execute a formal labor contract embodying the terms and conditions of the attached Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Milwaukee and the Milwaukee Police Association, Local #21, I.U.P.A., AFL-CIO; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the city negotiating team is directed to prepare any ordinance changes or resolutions to effectuate the agreement; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper city officials are directed to take the necessary action or to make the necessary recommendations to the Common Council or the appropriate committees or boards to implement the terms of this agreement; and be it

Further Resolved, That such sums as are necessary for the implementation of the aforementioned labor contract in accordance with its terms and conditions be obtained for and charged to the appropriate departmental budget accounts in accordance with the customary reporting and accounting requirements; and, be it

Further Resolved, That all resolutions or parts of resolutions contravening this resolution are rescinded.
