Resolution determining it necessary to make various assessable public improvements at various locations. (DPW)  
-Analysis-

This resolution authorizes engineering studies and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to determine any benefits or damages which would result if the projects were to be constructed. After the Commissioner files his report, a Public Hearing will be held on those projects determined assessable. A resolution will be submitted after the Public Hearing authorizing construction.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that it is necessary and in the public interest to do the following described work according to City specifications, and that such public improvements and resulting special assessments be made pursuant to Section 66.60 and any other pertinent sections of the Wisconsin Statutes and in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances:

3rd Aldermanic District

E. Thomas Ave. - N. Farwell Ave. to N. Oakland Ave. ST21100151 (870-0853-7): Paving the roadway with asphalt. Laying a concrete curb and gutter. Laying concrete sidewalk. Doing all the necessary grading pertaining to said work.

Alley between N. Bartlett Ave., N. Newhall St., E. Newport Ave., and E. Providence Ave. ST21200155 (880-0866-4): Paving the alley with concrete. Doing all the necessary grading pertaining to said work. (Nonassessable Alley Paving Fund -- \$5,000)

Alley between N. Cramer St., E. Linnwood Ave., E. Locust St., and N. Oakland Ave. ST21200154 (880-0864-3): Paving the alley with concrete. Doing all the necessary grading pertaining to said work. (Nonassessable Alley Paving Fund -- \$5,000)

5th Aldermanic District

W. Melvina St. - N. 93rd St. to N. 95th St. ST21100160 (877-1827-4): Paving the roadway with asphalt. Laying a concrete curb and gutter. Laying concrete sidewalk. Doing all the necessary grading pertaining to said work. (Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$5,000)

6th Aldermanic District

W. Randolph St. - N. 1st St. to N. 3rd St. ST21100159 (870-0865-2): Paving the roadway with asphalt. Laying a concrete curb and gutter. Laying concrete sidewalk. Doing all the necessary grading pertaining to said work. (Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$5,000)

7th Aldermanic District

W. Clarke St. - N. 23rd St. to N. 24th St. ST21100161 (870-0867-3): Paving the roadway with asphalt. Laying a concrete curb and gutter. Laying concrete sidewalk. Doing all the necessary grading pertaining to said work. (Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$5,000)

17th Aldermanic District

Alley between W. Meinecke Ave., W. North Ave., N 12th St., and N. 13th St. ST21200156 (880-0868-5): Paving the alley with concrete. Doing all the necessary grading pertaining to said work. (Nonassessable Alley Paving Fund -- \$5,000)

Further Resolved, That the abutting and adjacent properties be assessed a portion of the cost, said assessment to be recommended by the Commissioner of Public Works in his report; and, be it

Further Resolved, That all assessments and payments be made in accordance with Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That all City departments are authorized to do engineering, surveying, preparing of plans, and estimates of cost thereof, to be utilized in the preparation of said report of the Commissioner of Public Works; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts.
