Whereas, The Judiciary and Legislation Committee of the Common Council has recommended the following positions on the bills hereinafter listed and the Common Council being advised of said matters; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it hereby approves the following legislative bills and instructs the Division of Intergovernmental Relations to appear before the proper committees to support such bills and use its best endeavors to have the same enacted into law, viz:

AB-37/SB-34 Requiring certain persons to hold certificates of food protection practices to operate school lunchrooms participating in the National School Lunch program.

Further Resolved, That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee is opposed to the following legislative bills and hereby instructs the Division of Intergovernmental Relations to appear before the proper committees

in opposition to said bills and use its best endeavors in opposition to the same viz:

AB-94/SB-46 Causing harm to a child by co-sleeping while intoxicated, providing information about safe sleep, and providing a penalty.

AB-143/SB-106 Regulation of transportation network companies, providing an exemption from emergency rule procedures, granting rule-making authority, and providing a penalty.
