Substitute resolution relating to an appeal from Adam Roethig for property damage.

Whereas, Members of the Judiciary and Legislation Committee have reviewed the records to this claim in the amount of \$4,455.15, related to personal property that was damaged due to a backwater from the City’s sewer. Based on this review, members of the Committee recommend the claimant be reimbursed \$2,400 in payment of this claim; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the proper city officers be and they hereby are authorized and directed to issue a city check in the total sum of \$2,400 payable to Adam Roethig, 5609 W. Vine Street, Milwaukee, WI 53208, to reimburse for the loss; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the check is to be delivered upon presentation of a proper release, approved by the City Attorney; said amount to be charged to Account No. 636505, Fund - 0001, Organization - 1490, Program - 2631, Sub Class - S118. This resolution would release the City from any further liability arising from this incident.
