- ANALYSIS -

This resolution confirms the report of the Commissioner of Public Works for improvements on which the benefited property owner has waived his right to a public hearing. (Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$65; Assessable Reconstruction Paving Fund -- \$490) (SUFFICIENT FUNDS TRANSFERRED BY RESOLUTION FILE NUMBER 981178, ADOPTED DECEMBER 18, 1998)

Whereas, Waiver of notice and hearing of the abutting property owner at 1621 E. Irving Pl. has been filed; now, therefore, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper City departments take such action as is required of them to assess the abutting properties and collect such assessment in the manner directed by said Section 115-42.
