Resolution to vacate a portion of right-of-way on the East side of South Herman Street, located North of East Oklahoma Avenue, in the 14th Aldermanic District. (DCD)  
- Analysis -

This resolution vacates the above right-of-way in accordance with vacation proceedings under power granted to the City of Milwaukee by Section 66.297(1), Wisconsin Statutes, and Section 81-308-28 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances. Whereas, It is proposed that a portion of right-of-way on the East side of South Herman Street, located North of East Oklahoma Avenue, be vacated pursuant to the provisions of Section 66.297 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

Whereas, This proposed right-of-way vacation has been reviewed in accordance with Section 81-308-28 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that said public right-of-way, as indicated by Exhibit "A", is vacated; and, be it

Further Resolved, That as provided by Section 80.32(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, such vacation shall not terminate the easements and rights incidental thereto acquired by or belonging to any county, town, village or city, or to any utility or person in any underground structures, improvements or services, as enumerated or otherwise existing in said public right-of-way and in said description of land above described, both easements and rights and all rights of entrance, maintenance, construction and repair of entrance, maintenance, construction and repair with reference thereto shall continue as if such public right-of-way had not been vacated.
