Whereas, The Common Council approved the inclusion of a footnote in the 2020 Adopted City Budget, directing the Health Commissioner and the Chief of Police to prepare a plan to use City resources to reduce violence in the City; and

Whereas, Violence is both a public health and a public safety concern; and

Whereas, A concerted effort by both the Health Department and the Police Department offers the greatest potential for a systemic and long-lasting reduction in violence in the city; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of Milwaukee, that the Health Commissioner and the Chief of

Police are directed to prepare a plan to use City resources to reduce violence in the city; and, be it

Further Resolved, This plan shall be presented to the Common Council by April 30, 2020.
