SUBSTITUTE 1

ALD. BREIER AND PAWLINSKI

A substitute ordinance establishing a special use permit requirement for new transmission towers located within 500 feet of existing transmission towers. 295-413-1-m cr

This ordinance provides that, in order for a newly-constructed transmission tower to be classified as a limited use, the tower shall be located at least 500 feet from the nearest existing transmission tower. If the proposed tower cannot meet this requirement, the tower shall be classified as a special use. The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 295-413-1-m of the code is created to read:

295-413. Transmission Towers.
