THE CHAIR

Substitute ordinance to further amend the 2003 rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service under control of the Common Council. The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 2 of ordinance File Number 020486 relative to rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service is hereby amended as follows:

Under salary grade 005, delete the title "Water Maintenance Scheduler."

Part 2. Section 18 of ordinance File Number 020486 relative to rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service is hereby amended as follows (Effective Pay Period 1, 2001 - December 24, 2000):

Delete Pay Ranges 801 through 813 in their entirety and create new Pay Ranges 801 through 813 as follows:
