An ordinance relating to maintenance of bird feeders.
78-35 am
This ordinance requires that:

1. Bird feeders be maintained in a sanitary condition and be cleaned regularly.
 2. Areas below bird feeders be kept free of accumulations of feed.
- The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 78-35 of the code is amended to read:

78-35. Bird Feeding. Feed for birds shall be placed in a covered hopper, gravity-type feeder. The platform of the ~~[[feeders]]~~ >>feeder<< shall be of reasonable size and surrounded by a ledge to deter food from blowing off. The feeder shall be placed on top of a rodent-proof pole which extends at least 3.5 feet above the ground and shall be placed at least 6 feet from the nearest climbable object, or the feeder may be suspended from a tree if protected by rodent guards. Feed for birds shall not be placed on the ground where it is accessible to rodents. No more than 4 bird feeders shall be located

on any premises. >>The feeder shall be maintained in a sanitary condition and cleaned regularly.
The area below the feeder shall also be kept free of accumulations of feed.<<
