Substitute resolution relative to acceptance and funding of the 2024-2025 Cities Readiness Initiative grant from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services.

Resolution/Substitute resolution authorizes the Health Department to accept, and fund the 2024-2025 Cities Readiness Initiative grant from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services in the amount of \$248,637 with a City share of \$0 and a grantor share of \$248,637. The funding will provide planning and tools needed in the case of a large emergency or natural disaster, and assure Milwaukee can access key Federal resources in emergency situations.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services to provide planning and tools needed in the case of a large emergency or natural disaster; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant program from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025 will cost \$248,637 comprised of \$248,637, or 100%, grantor share and \$0, or 0%, City share; now, therefore, be it;
