1/ Jerome Burr shall be frozen at the biweekly pay rate of \$2,031.54 and Robert Mielcarek shall be frozen at the biweekly pay rate of \$1,960.98, except for across-the-board pay increases that may be negotiated in collective negotiations, until such time they obtain the DNR Distribution Operator certification. Such employees shall advance to the next higher pay step in Pay Range 288 at least \$10.00 higher than their current rate, the next pay period following their attainment of their DNR Distribution Operator License.

Part 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Part 4. The provisions of Part 1 of this ordinance are deemed to have been in force and effect from and after Pay Period 1, 2008 (December 30, 2007).

The provisions of all other parts of this ordinance are deemed to be in force and effect from and after the first day of the first pay period following passage and publication.

Part 5. This ordinance will take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
